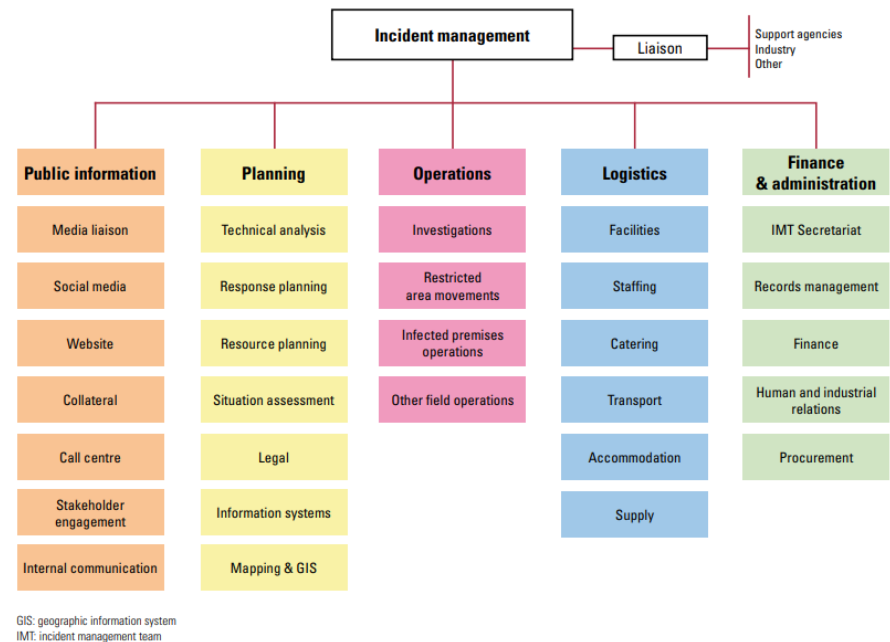

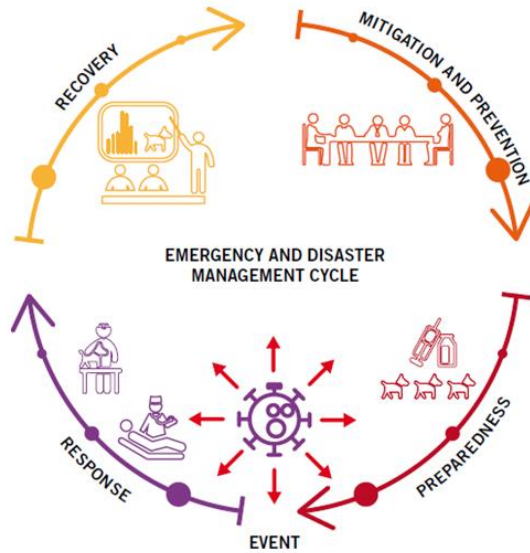

- Information management

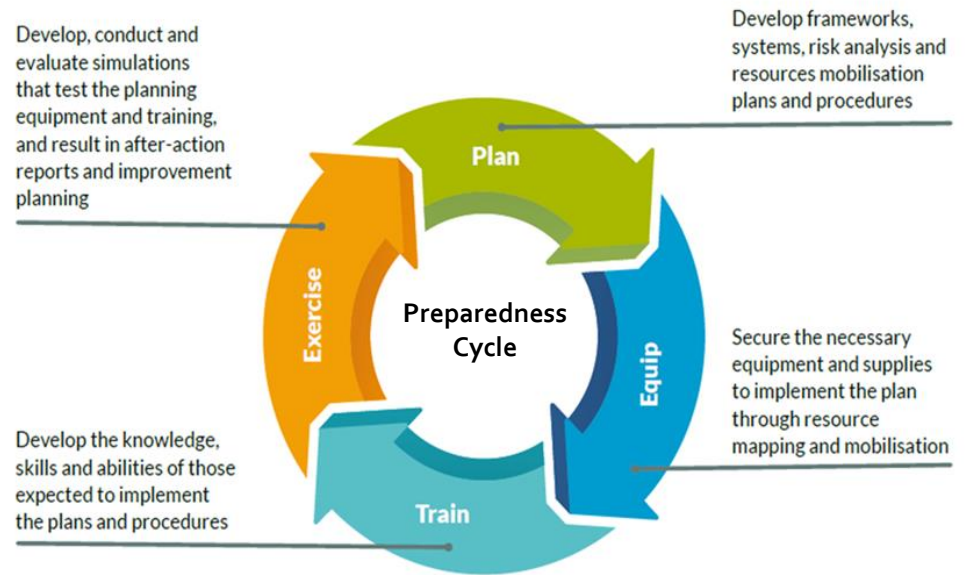

Emergency and Disaster Management Cycle



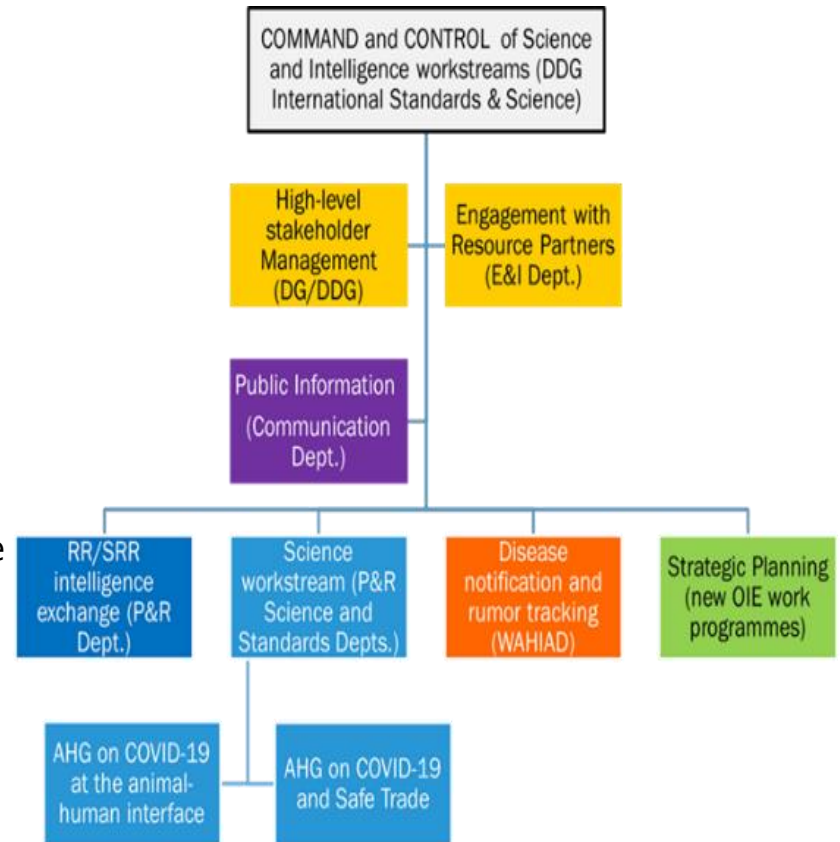

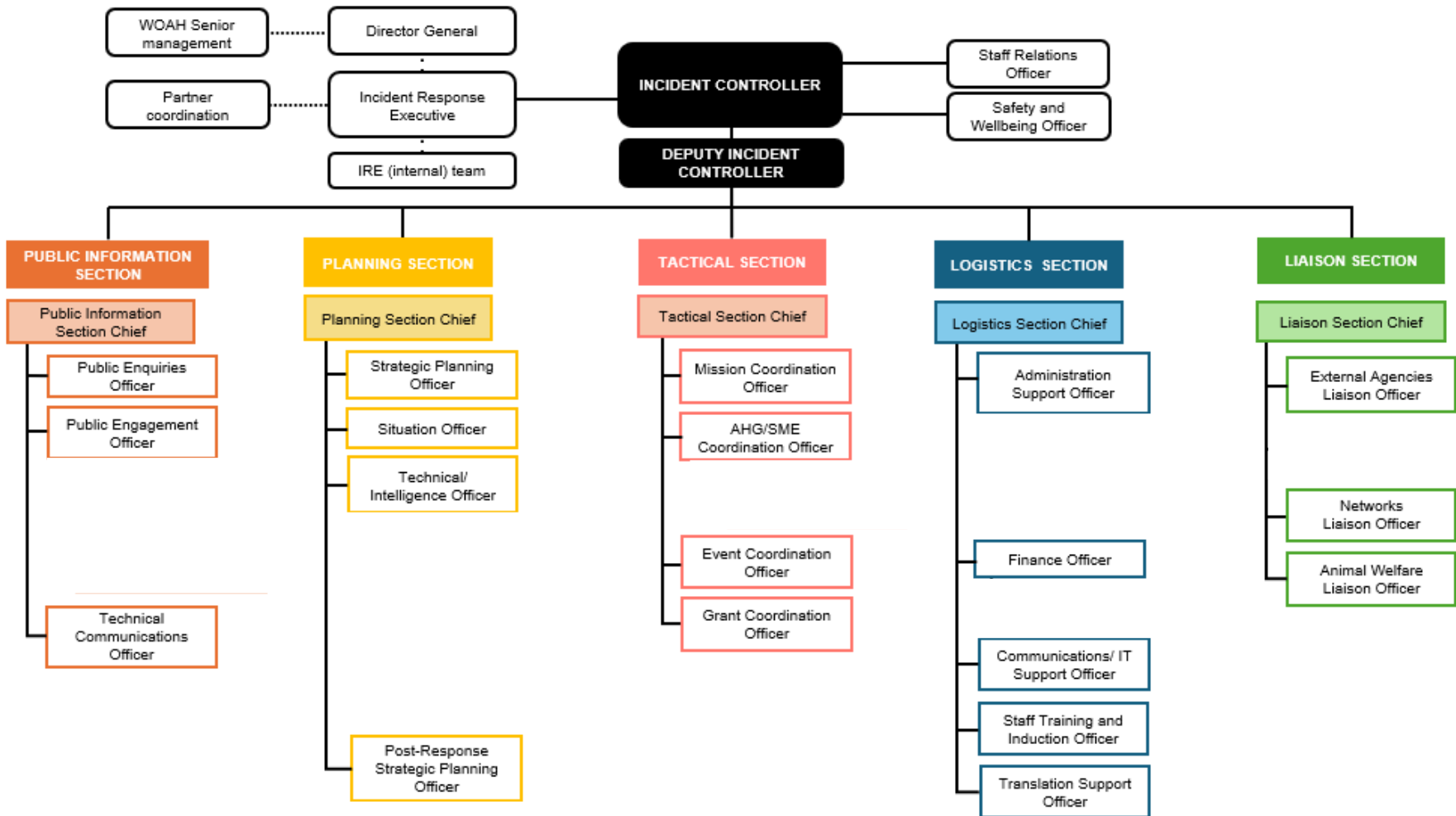

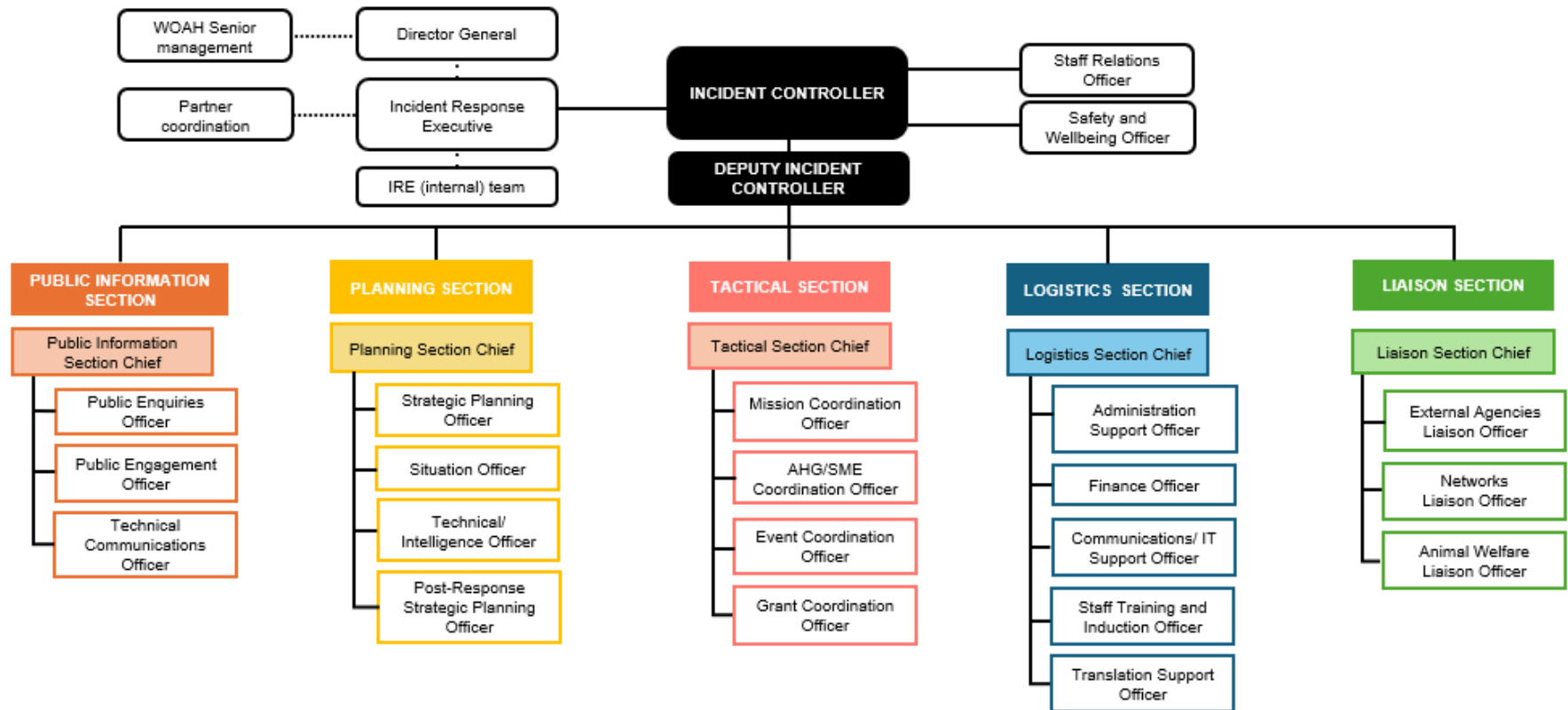

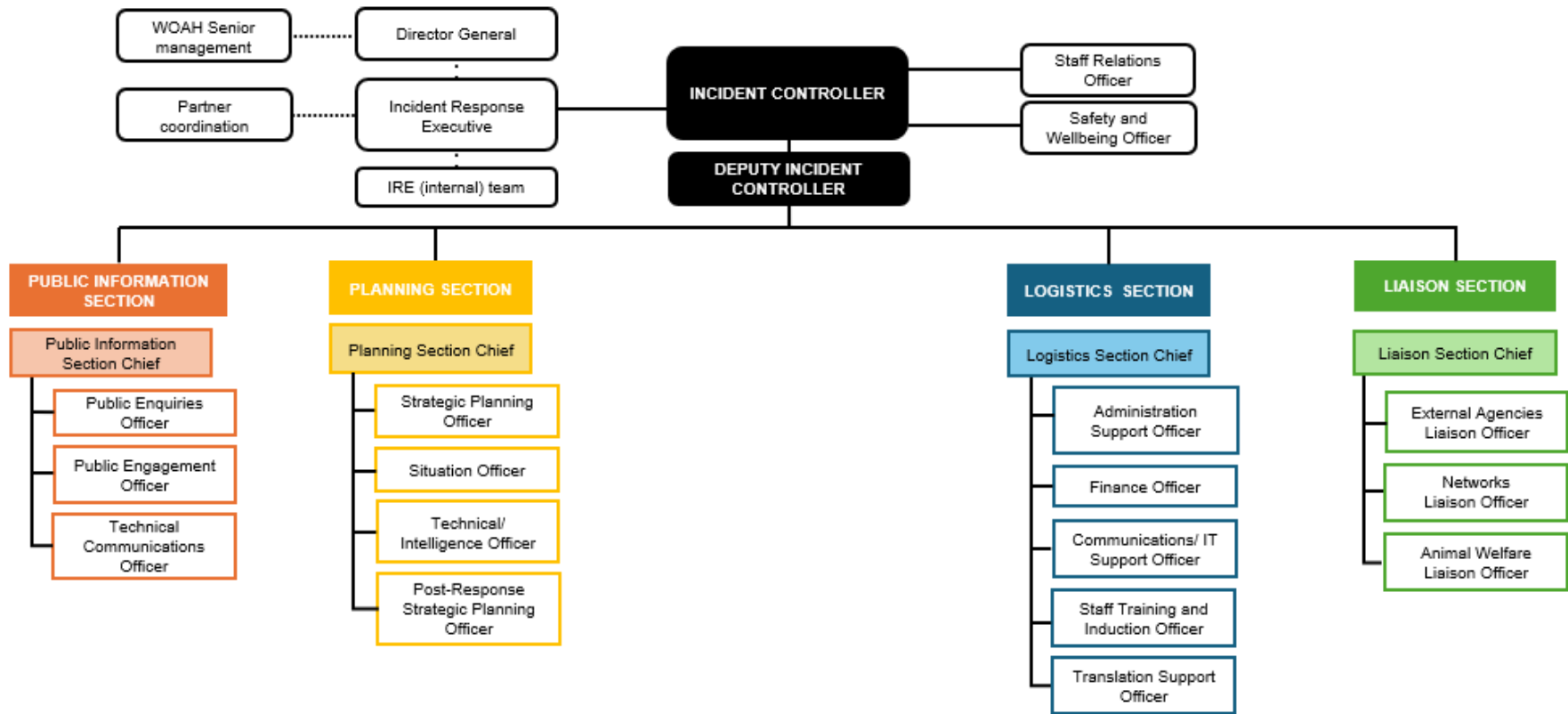
