Aquatic Code and Terrestrial Code

Standards for the improvement of animal health and welfare, and veterinary public health worldwide, including the prevention of disease spread through international trade of animals and animal products.

Aquatic Manual and Terrestrial Manual

Standards for diagnostic tests and vaccines (*Terr. Manual* only).

WOAH Standards

Recognised by the World Trade Organization SPS Agreement (the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures Agreement) as the International Standard Setting Organisation for animal health and zoonoses.



Used by Veterinary or Competent Authorities

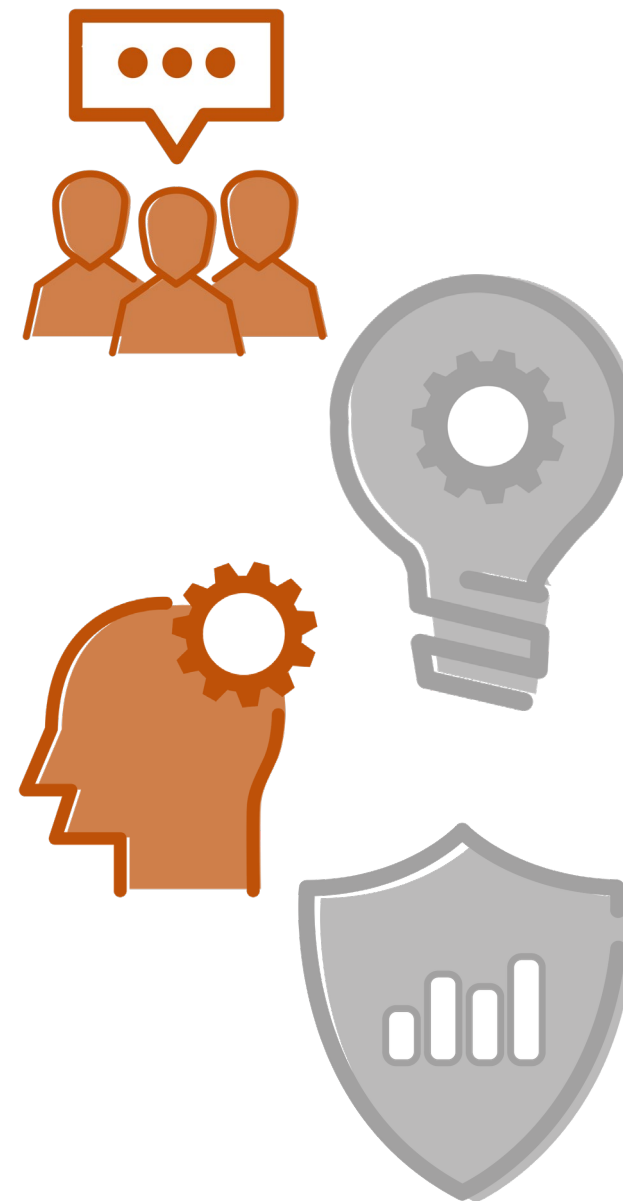

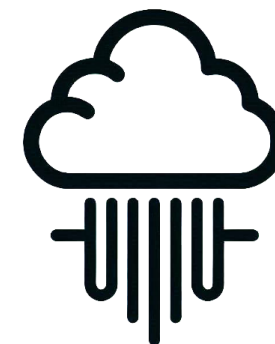
Outputs

1. Public WOAAH Website:

- Recommendations for Safe International Trade by Commodity: A tool allowing users to visualize trade recommendations with a filtering system (currently for the Terrestrial Code, with potential expansion to the Aquatic Code).
- Navigation and Search Tool: An intuitive interface for navigating WOAAH's terrestrial and aquatic codes and manuals.

2. Internal WOAAH Use:

- Internal Interface: A dedicated platform to efficiently manage and update WOAAH International Standards, following adoption of new or revised text at the WOAAH General Assembly.

Greater collaboration among WOAAH departments



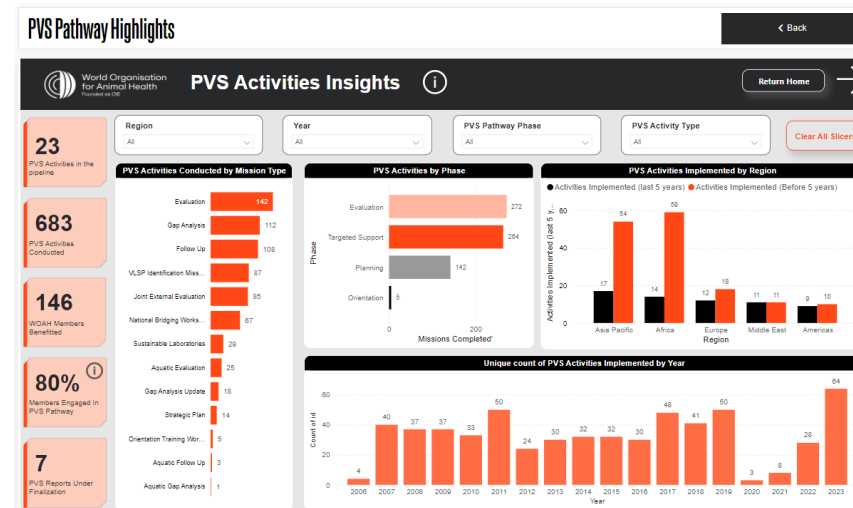


Linking to Other Digital Tools

Objective

Obtain WOAHA recommendations to ensure the safe import of bovine meat

Methodology: Import risk analysis

1. Internal discussion to consider the relevant diseases and the specific measures provided in the *Terrestrial Code*
2. Use of the “Recommendations for safe international trade by commodity”
3. Consider animal health status at origin
4. Export the report to discuss with the technical teams



Result

Issue WOAH recommendations from the *Terrestrial Code* needed to ensure the safe import of bovine meat
