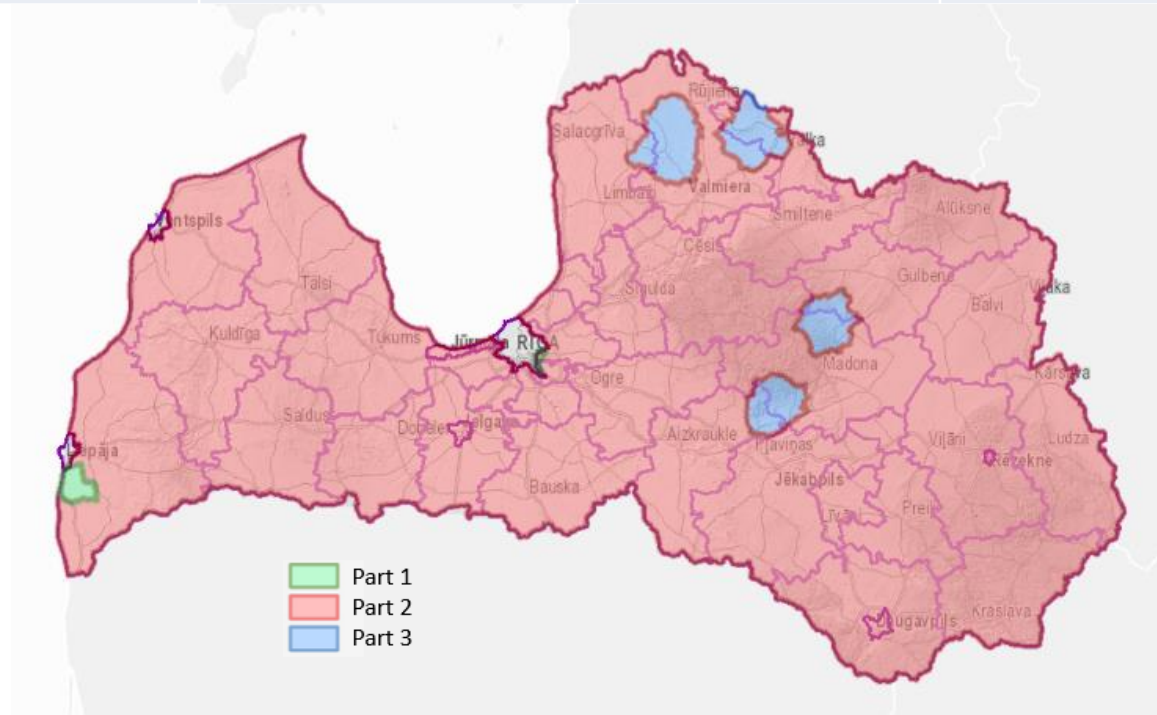

# Wild boar surveillance

1st September 2023 – 31st August 2024

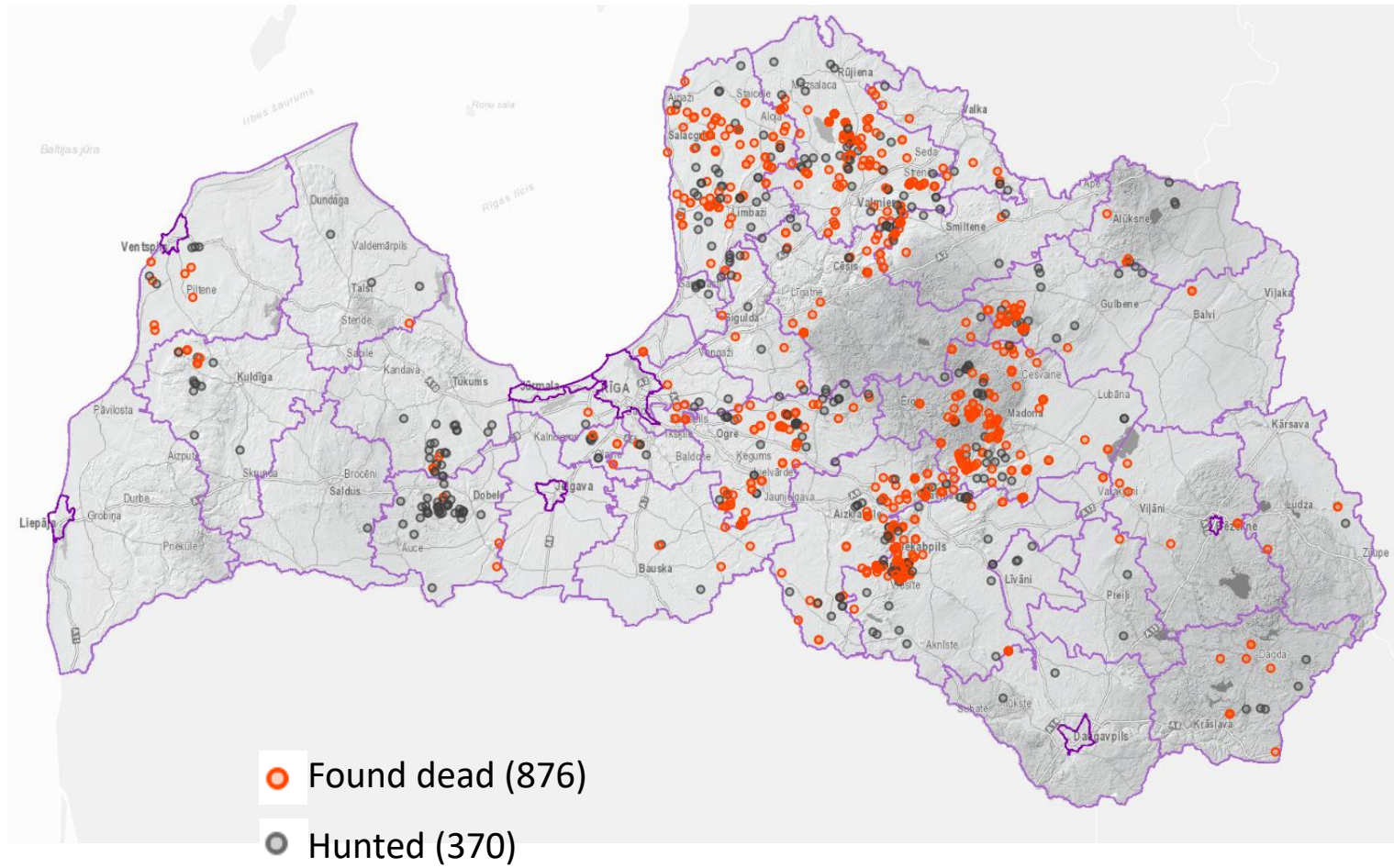
	N°	% PCR positive	% seropositive
Wild boar found dead	954*	91,8%*	N/A
Wild boar hunted	18 688	2%	N/A



\*only 3 animals (samples) are tested in a case of large group of found dead animals (same location). Pooling of 3 samples is performed and result is applied to the group.

1st September 2023 – 31st August 2024

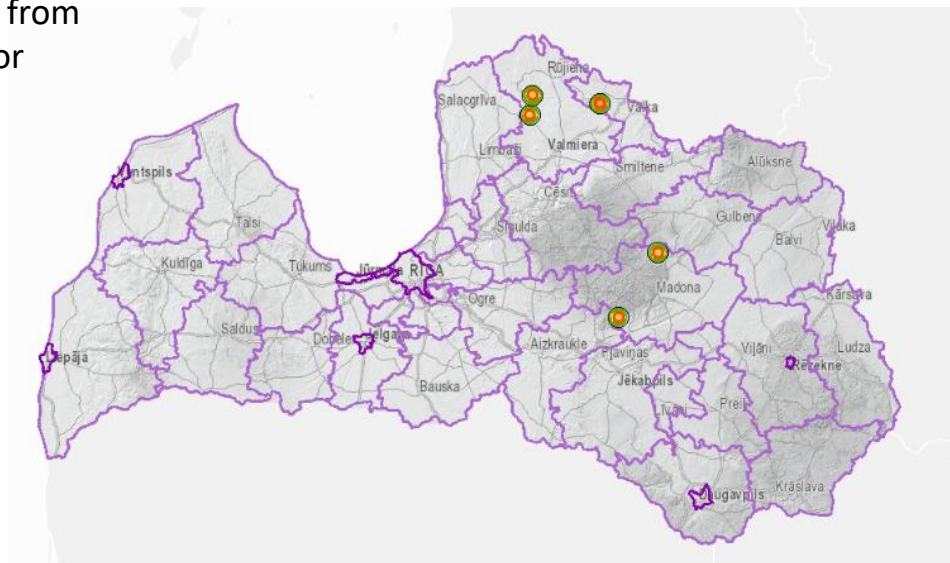

## Enhanced passive surveillance in commercial pig farms -

every week samples from at least first two dead pigs from every epidemiological unit shall be sent to the NRL for laboratory testing to the presence of ASFV.

In total, 6 ASF outbreaks were confirmed in areas where ASFV are confirmed in wild boar population:

- 2 outbreaks in small commercial farms (24-527 pigs).
- 4 outbreaks in backyard farms (1-2 pigs).
