- Food and Veterinary Agency (FVA): Monitoring and control
- Farmers: Implementation of welfare practices
- Veterinarians: Healthcare services
- Private veterinarians: Delegation of official duties for ante-mortem and post-mortem inspections

- •Law on Animal Welfare in Kosovo
- Veterinary Law
- National regulations and administrative guidelines based on WOAH and EU standards



## Implementation and enforcement – what are the main actions taken to implement and enforce your regulatory framework?

- Regular inspections in farms and slaughterhouses
- Inspections during transport
- Reports from citizens and civil society organizations
- Awareness campaigns
- •Sanctions for legal violations

- Collaboration with NGOs for reporting



### Public awareness or educational programs – What programs are currently in place in your country?

- Awareness campaigns for citizens and farmers
- Training for veterinarians and inspectors
- Activities organized by NGOs



# Barriers and challenges – What barriers and challenges do you face to implement Animal Welfare regulation (cultural, economical, political, ...)?

- Lack of sufficient funding
- Cultural changes and lack of awareness among farmers and citizens
- Limited capacities for implementation and monitoring
- Need for harmonization of legislation with European standards
