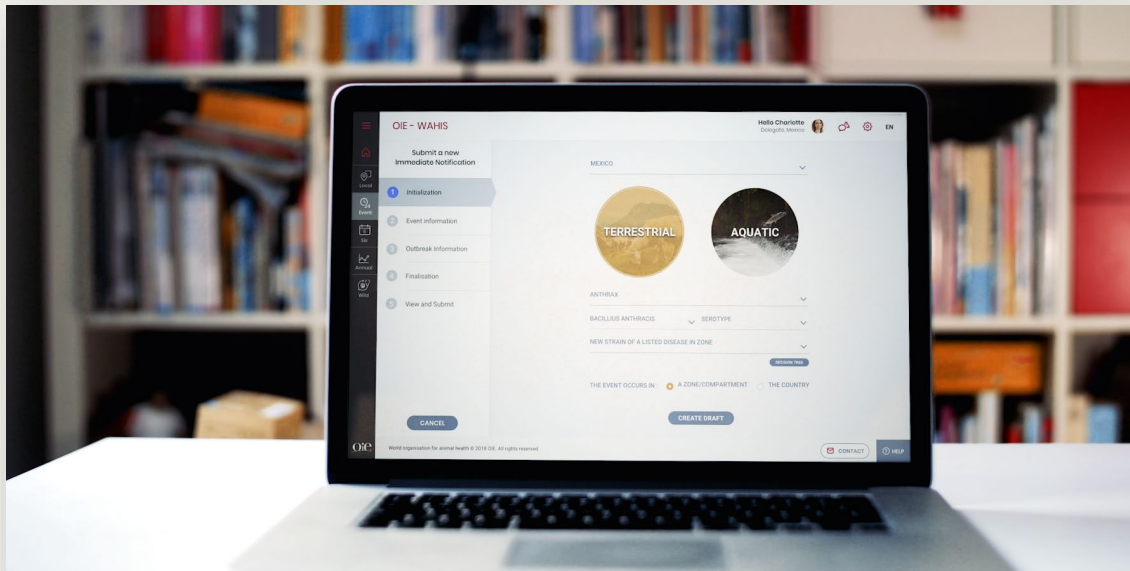

Reporting obligations

ASF is a WOAAH-listed disease.

Mandatory for national Veterinary Authorities to notify WOAAH of any ASF case in a timely manner.

Members may also self-declare the absence of ASF from their territory on a voluntary basis.

2014: Spread to the EU

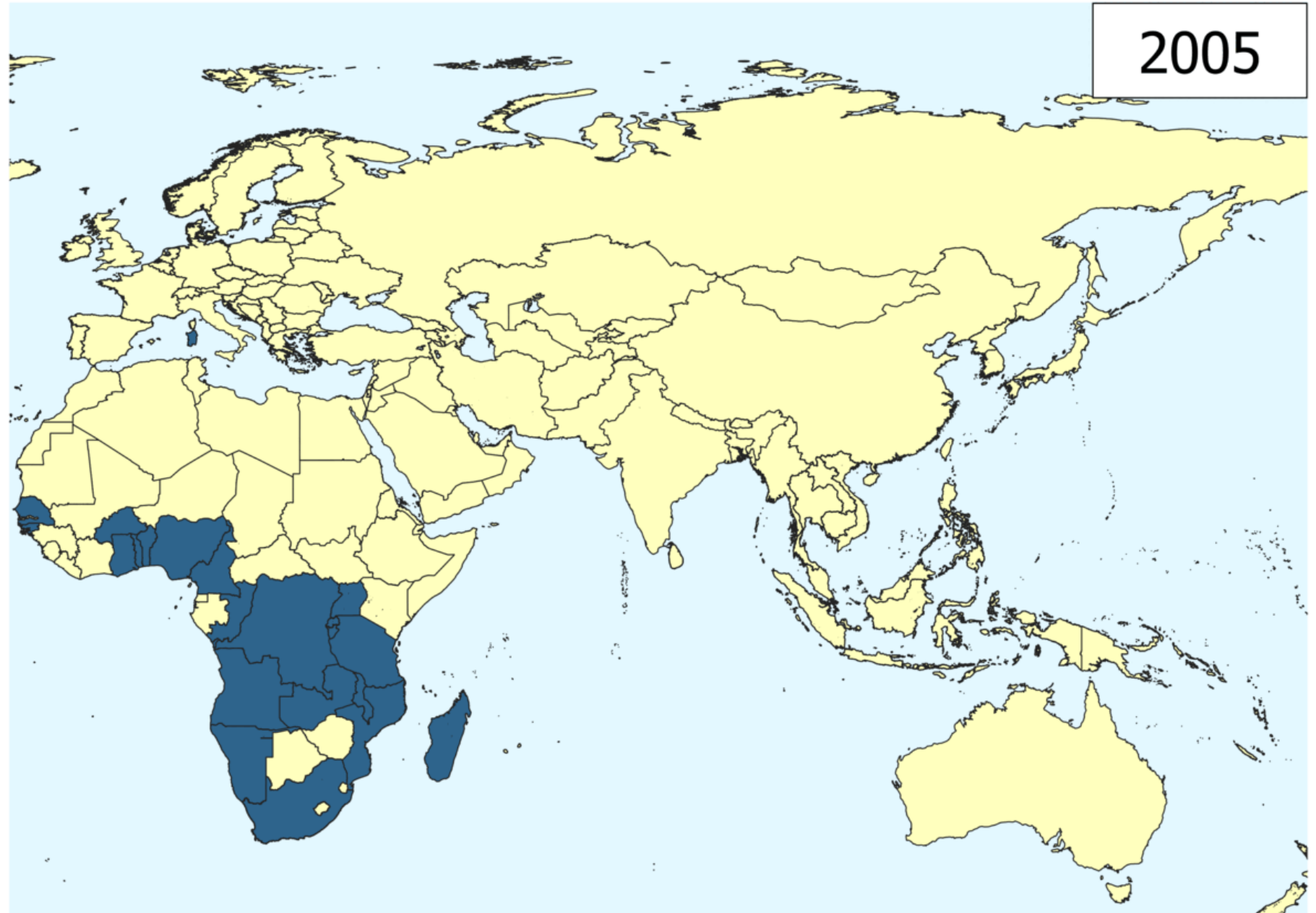
2018: Emergence in Asia

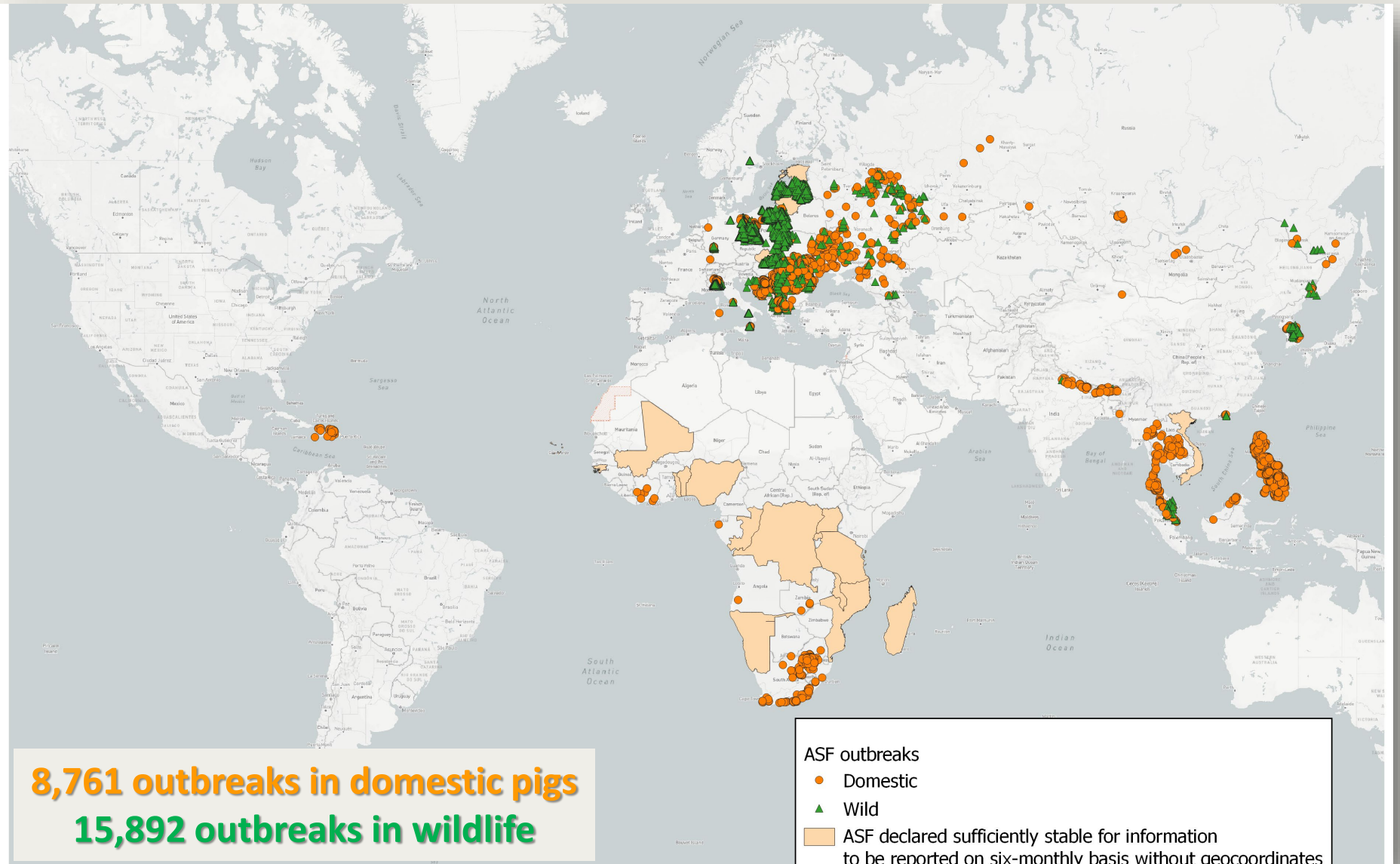




Global ASF situation

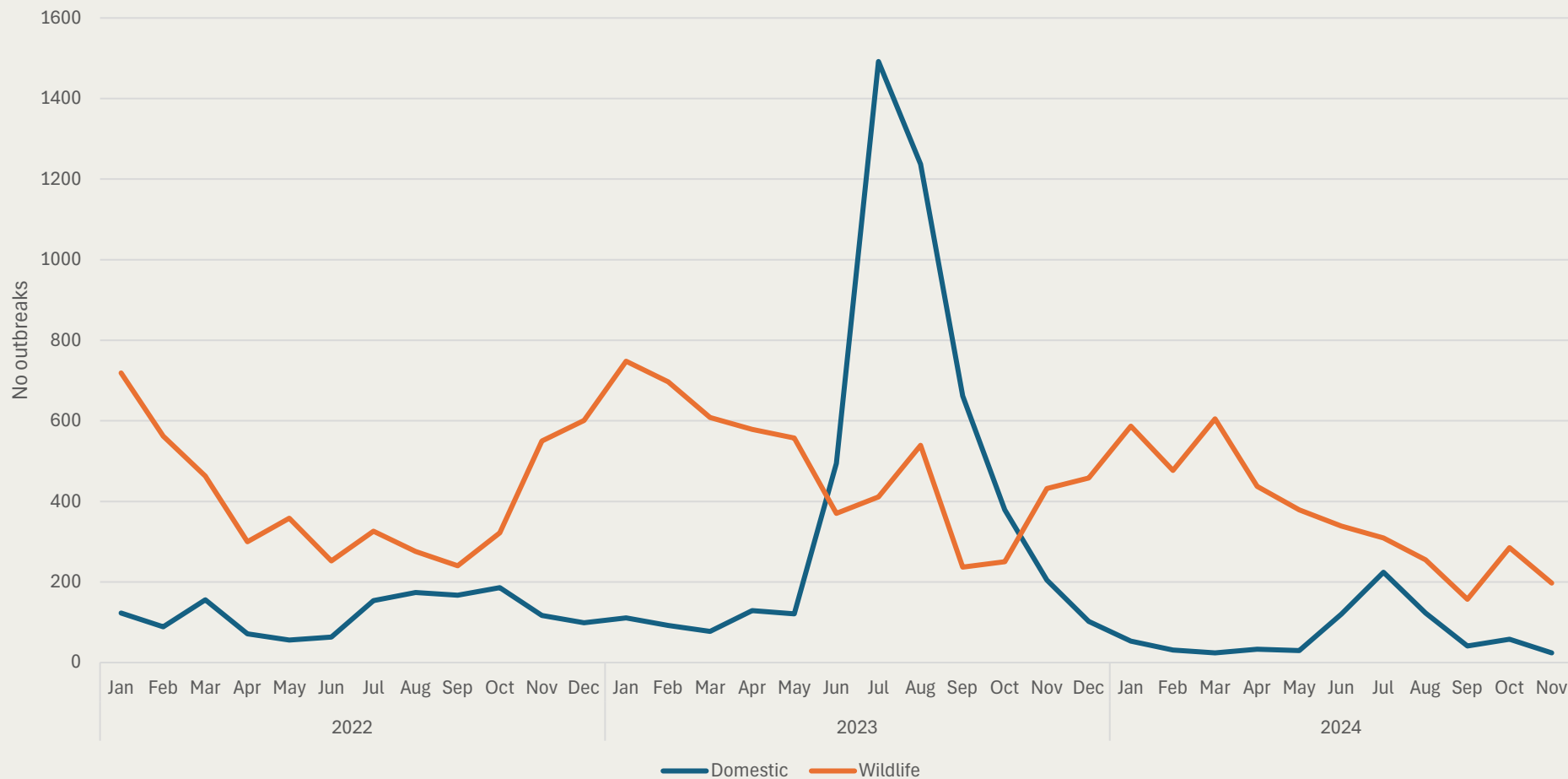

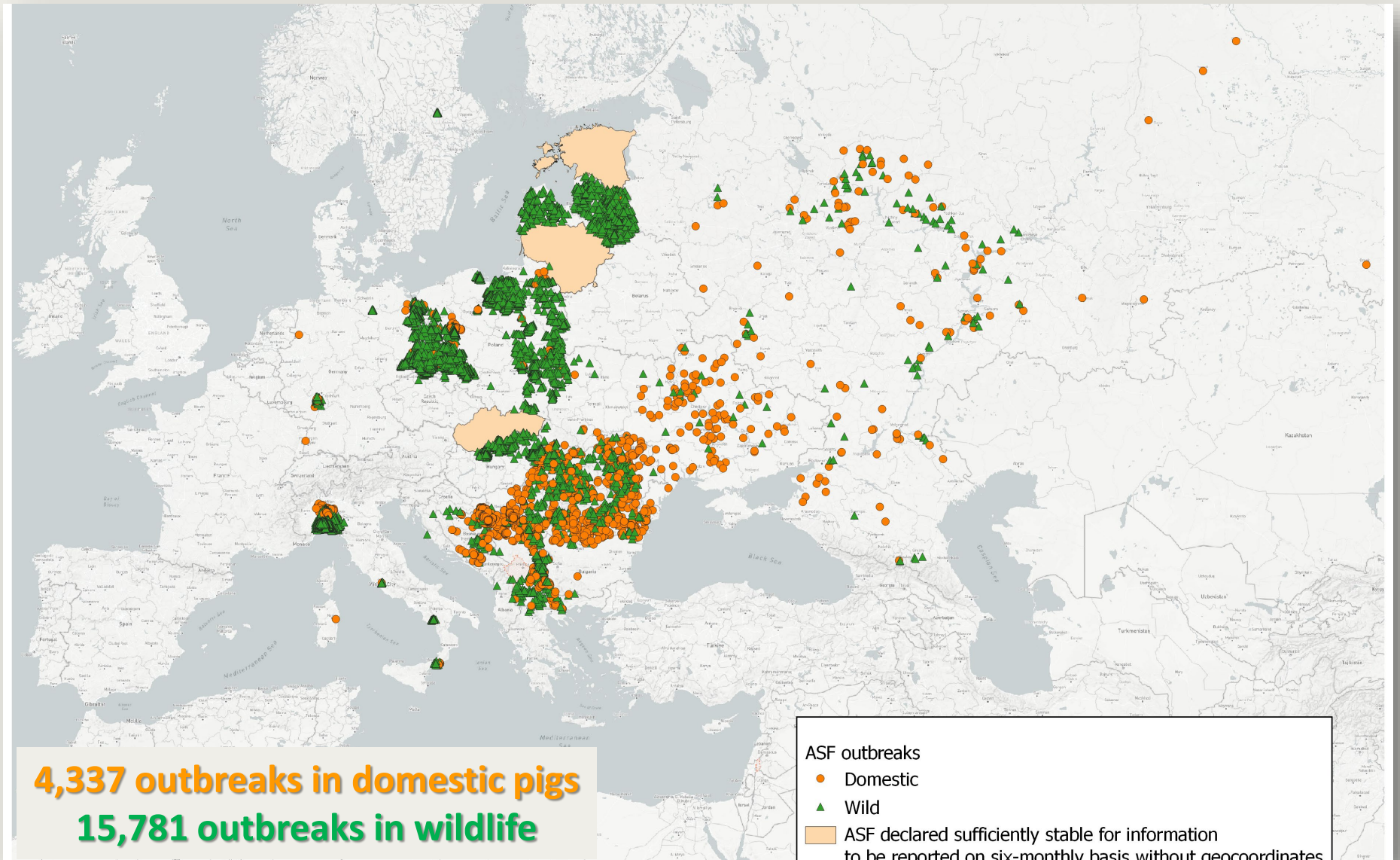

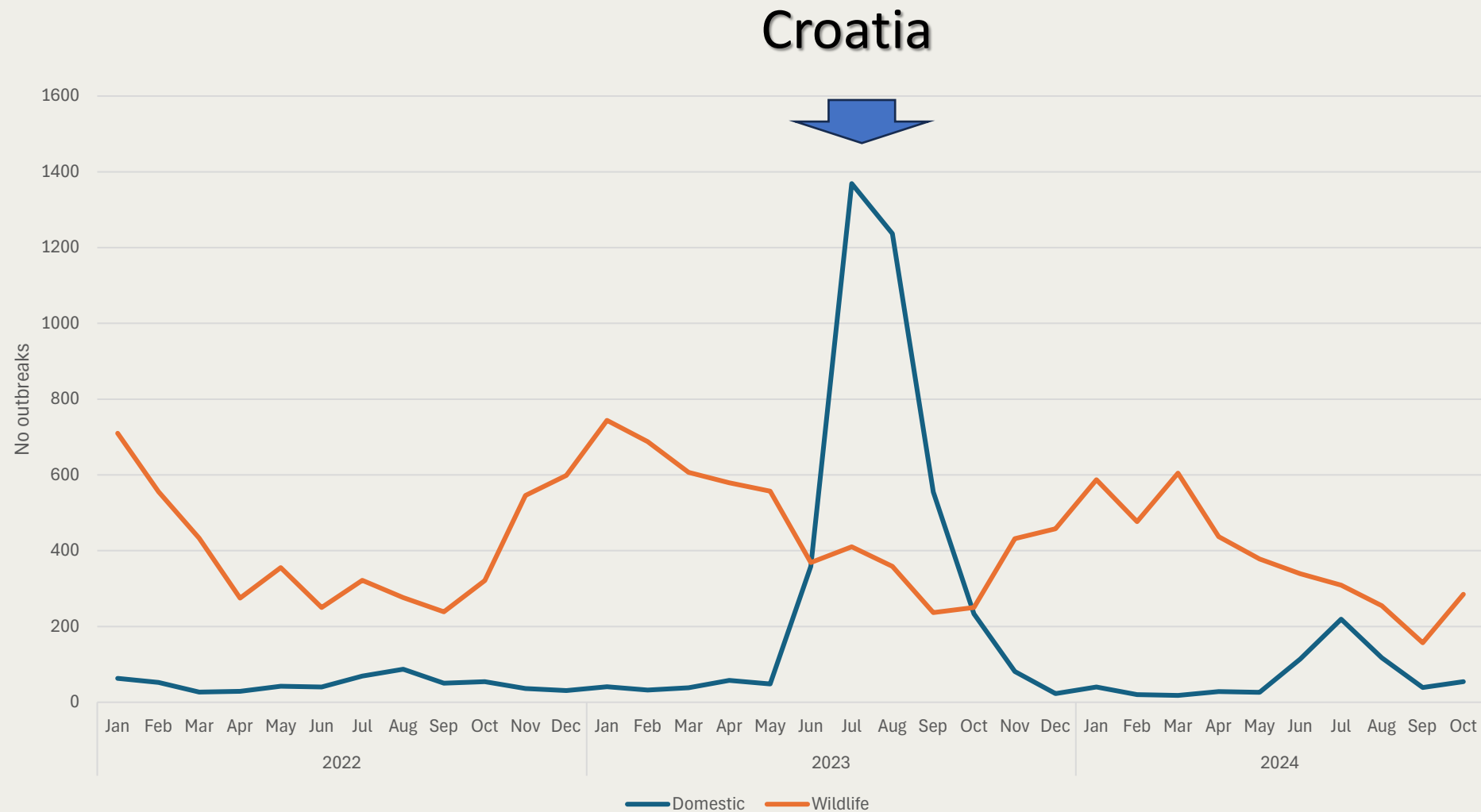
