CHAPTER 1.1.

NOTIFICATION OF DISEASES AND PROVISION OF EPIDEMIOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Article 1.1.3.

Veterinary Authorities shall, under the responsibility of the Delegate, send to the Headquarters:


- 1. in accordance with relevant provisions in the disease-specific chapters, notification, through the World Animal Health Information System (WAHIS) or by fax or email within 24 hours, of any of the following events:
 - first occurrence of a listed disease in a country, a zone or a compartment;
 - recurrence of an eradicated *listed disease* in a country, a zone or a compartment following the final report that declared the event ended;
 - first occurrence of a new strain of a pathogenic agent of a listed disease in a country, a zone or a compartment;
 - recurrence of an eradicated strain of a pathogenic agent of a listed disease in a country, a zone or a compartment following the final report that declared the event
 - a sudden and unexpected change in the distribution or increase in incidence or virulence of, or morbidity or mortality caused by, the pathogenic agent of a listed disease present within a country, a zone or a compartment;
 - f. occurrence of a listed disease in an unusual host species;
- weekly reports subsequent to a notification under point 1 above, to provide further information on the evolution of the event which justified the notification. These reports should continue until the listed disease has been eradicated or the situation has become sufficiently stable that six-monthly reporting under point 3 will satisfy the obligation of the Member Country. For each event notified, a final report should be submitted;
- six-monthly reports on the absence or presence and evolution of listed diseases and information of epidemiological significance to other Member Countries;
- annual reports concerning any other information of significance to other Member Countries.




LSD situation update: global situation (2021 – 2025)

- Disease reported as endemic in most of African countries
- Historically absent in the Americas
- Started to spread to Eastern Europe, Middle East and Asia since 2012
- Still never reported in most of European countries
- Between 2021 and 2025 only Russia reported outbreaks




LSD situation update: global situation (2021 – 2025)





LSD situation update: new outbreaks (2016 - 2025)




In Europe:

- 2016 : first occurrence in Albania, Bulgaria, Georgia, North Macedonia and Serbia
- Russia is only country reporting Early warning outbreaks since 2018 up until 2025 (as of 04/03/2025)
