




ASF SITUATION from 1st September 2024 to 15th March 2025 Germany






Violet – ASF only in one establishment

Blue – free area surrounding RZ II





ASF surveillance in RZ II and RZ I in the south of BB


As of November 2024

→ districts and municipalities with no ASF cases ever or for at least 12 months






ASF – infected zone in BB


As of November 22nd, 2024

- single carcass freshly dead
- infected zone with 10 km radius (330km²)
- preliminary electronic fencing
- active search for carcasses with dog teams and drones
- epi investigations with support FLI
- all bones found were ASF negative, also between infected zone and RZ I/ II
 - all hunted wild boar virologically and serologically tested within the district as well as neighbouring districts





ASF infected zone in district Oberhavel, BB search for carcasses + surveillance of hunted and indicator animals All of them negative





ASF in kept porcine animals in HE – one outbreak in kept wild boar

In November 2024

Game park for cultural and educational purposes

- → regular checks by competent authority
- → killing of all 19 animals on day of suspicion after death of 5
- \rightarrow high amount of virus
- → introduction via illegal feed most likely
- → good biosecurity (triple fences, no visitors close to animals since July)





Exemplary ASF measures in RP + HE Regular active search for carcasses

Overview map of areas actively searched for carcasses (as of January 20th, 2025)

- → Movement restrictions
- → Check of pig establishments (no pig industry area)
- → Active search for carcasses (appr. 350.000 ha)
- → Eradication in affected pig establishments
- → Epidemiological investigations including FLI closed

Overview map of fencing building measures (as of January 20th, 2025)

- → E and solid fencing completed and ongoing (>800km)
- → White zones being established
- → Trapping
