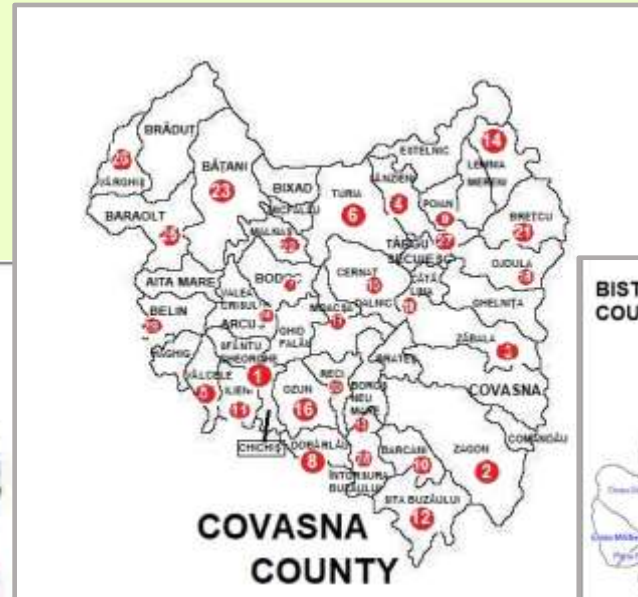
- The Veterinary Authority numbers per county were calculated as densities (equids per square mile), ranked and represented on maps.

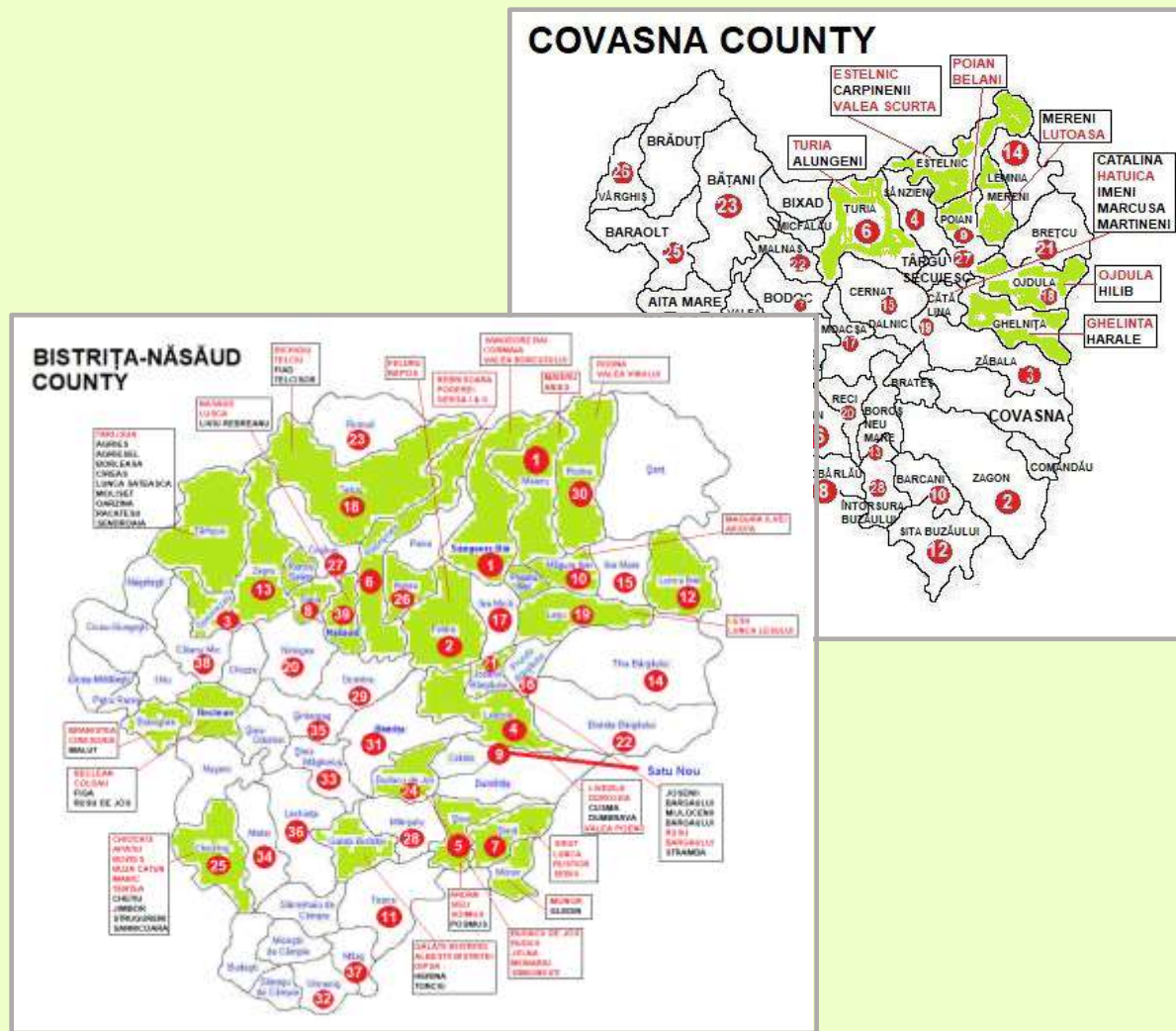

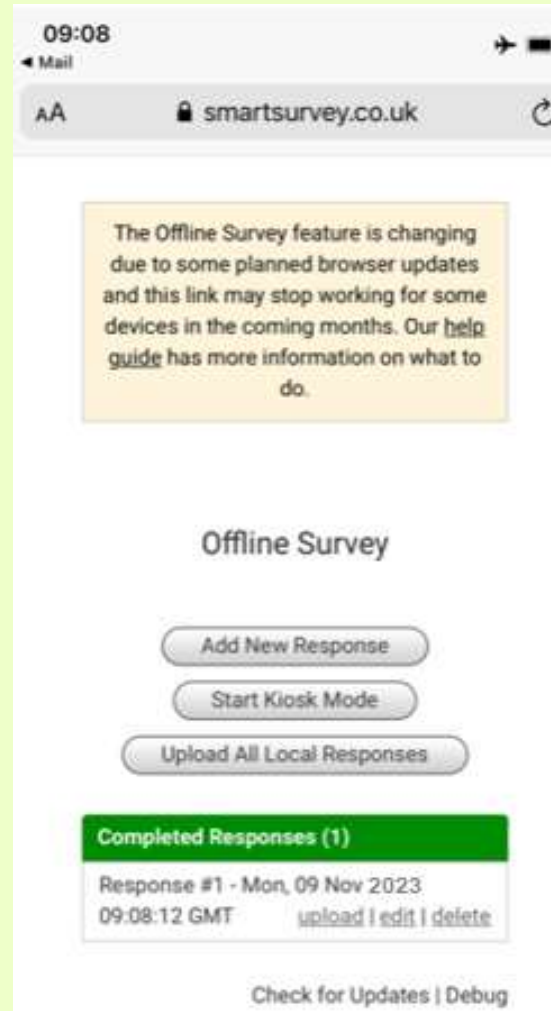

Working equid welfare assessments

- Protocol devised by World Horse Welfare;
- For assessors who complete a training;
- Collects data on an online platform;
- Allows statistic processing of the data.

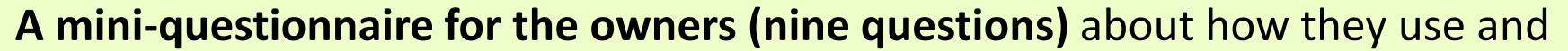

(species, age, gender, HHR test, BCS, wounds, hoof condition, lameness, external

parasites, signs of disease).

The way forward – Дальнейшие действия

- Four project locations were selected for community work to:
 - Strengthen collaboration with horse owners, veterinarians and farriers;
 - Build a sustainable positive attitude towards working horses, including involvement in children and young adult education;
 - Facilitate bilateral learning and co-creation.
- Для работы с населением были выбраны четыре места реализации проекта:
 - Укрепление сотрудничества с владельцами лошадей, ветеринарами и кузнецами;
 - Формирование устойчивого позитивного отношения к рабочим лошадинам, включая вовлечение в обучение детей и молодежи;
 - Содействие двустороннему обучению и совместному творчеству.
