


European Civil Protection Pool

The European Civil Protection Pool is a system whereby Member States can **pre-commit response capacities** for EU civil protection missions.

The **quality** of the assistance is ensured through a **certification process** and quality criteria.

In return for their commitment of assets, **Member States benefit from financial support** from the European Commission to develop, transport and operate these capacities where they are needed → Up to 75% of transport and operational costs.

In 2019, the EU introduced an additional layer to its Civil Protection Mechanism rescEU



Other types of operational support provided through UCPM

- Early warning and analytical support
- Co-financing of transport and operational costs
- **Satellite imagery**: Copernicus Emergency Management Service
- **Facilitation of coordination** with Civil Protection authorities, other competent authorities and emergency response stakeholders.
- Common Emergency Communication and Information
 System CECIS
- Information products and analyses: ECHO Civil Protection Messages, Daily Flash and Daily Map, etc.



COVID-19


- 174 requests for (medical) assistance between 2020 and 2024
- Deployment of medical teams, vaccines, medical equipment, personal protective equipment, ...
- Spontaneous offers from MS/PS and mobilisation of rescEU stockpiles
- November 2020: request for protective suits following an outbreak of mutated coronavirus in mink farms
