
79 outbreaks


June 20 1st outbreak in Italy (Sardinia)

June 29 1st outbreak in France in Savoie.


July 12 1st outbreak in Haute-Savoie

August 23 1st outbreak in Ain


Sept 18 1 outbreak in Rhône




Evolution of the Restricted Zone 1/2


















Restricted zone as of September 9, 2025

Vaccination campaign in the first restricted Zone

86% of vaccinated cattle in the restricted zone (as of today)

Vaccination will be launched ASAP in the second restricted zone

July 1st Ordering doses to the European Commission

July 15 Delivery of doses in France

July 18

First vaccinations, covered by the government, administered by veterinarians





40 413 cattle

Started on September 1st



941 cattle farm

75% cattle in 442 holdings



Total Culling: how to explain this measure and implement it?

Arguments	Details
Scientists	 1 outbreak = 1 Epidemiological unit approach; No reliable test available for asymptomatic animals Demonstration by EURL of transmission by asymptomatic animals.
Definition of the strategy	 Culling = in addition to movement control and emergency vaccination Approach defined in consultation with professional representatives and then validated collectively
Legal	Legal and technical support from the central level
Financial	Evaluation of the value of animalsRapid compensation for farmers
Culling process	 Method in accordance with R(EU) 1099/2009 (anesthesia and subsequent culling by injection); Support from law enforcement; Immediate removal of cadavers
Crisis communication	Many posts on social media and press communicates

Financial support: compensation for farmers affected



Urgent need to quickly replenish the cash reserves of affected farmers and provide maximum support for herd recapitalization.

→ Exceptional and rapid measures taken.

<u>Shortening</u> of the payment period and <u>cash advance</u> to the owner of the animals within days of slaughter.

Over 3 millions€ paid to date

- **Early detection is key**
- > Movement prohibition/restriction of cattle in the restricted area
- > Total culling on spot
- Emergency protective vaccination
- > Communication with all stakeholders and the public
