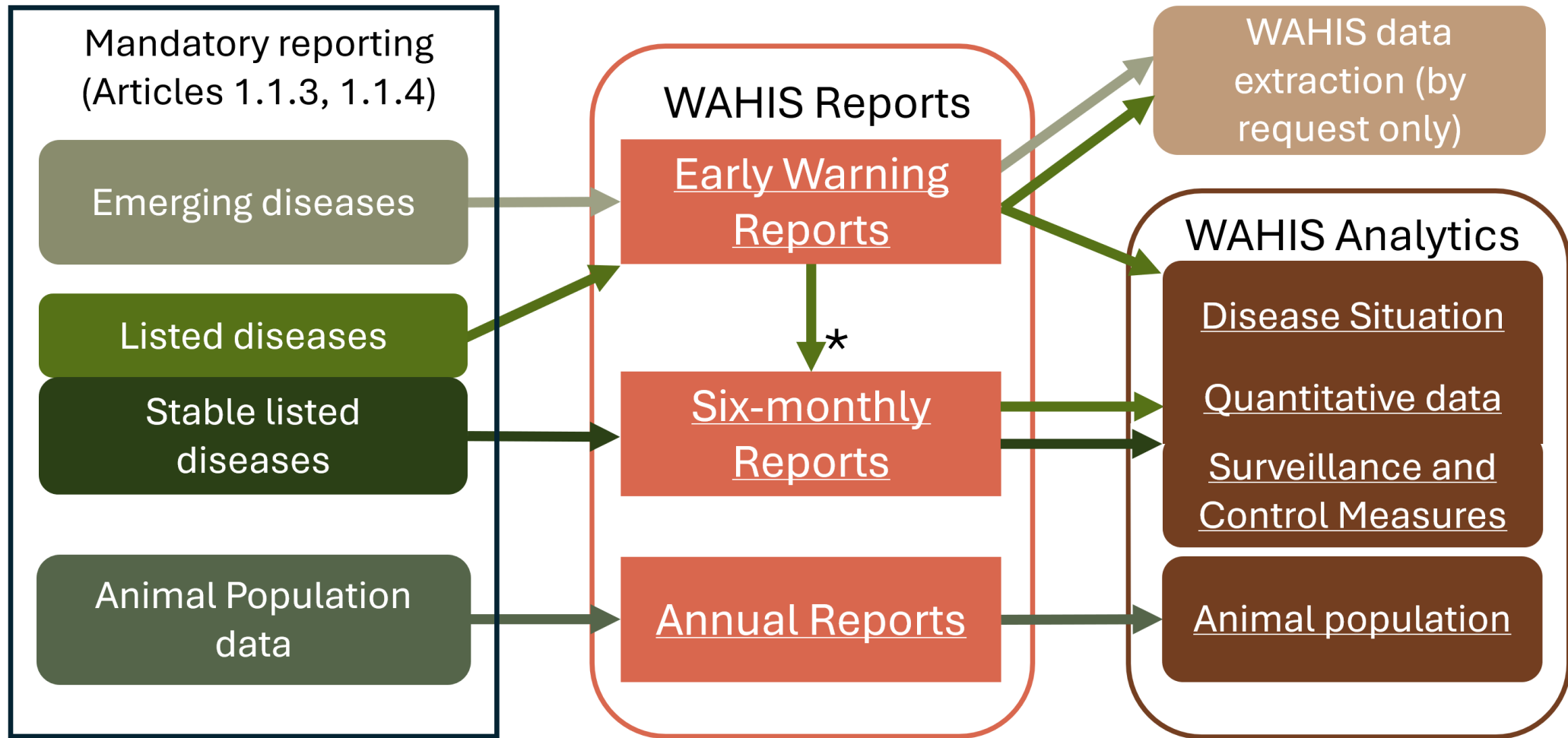

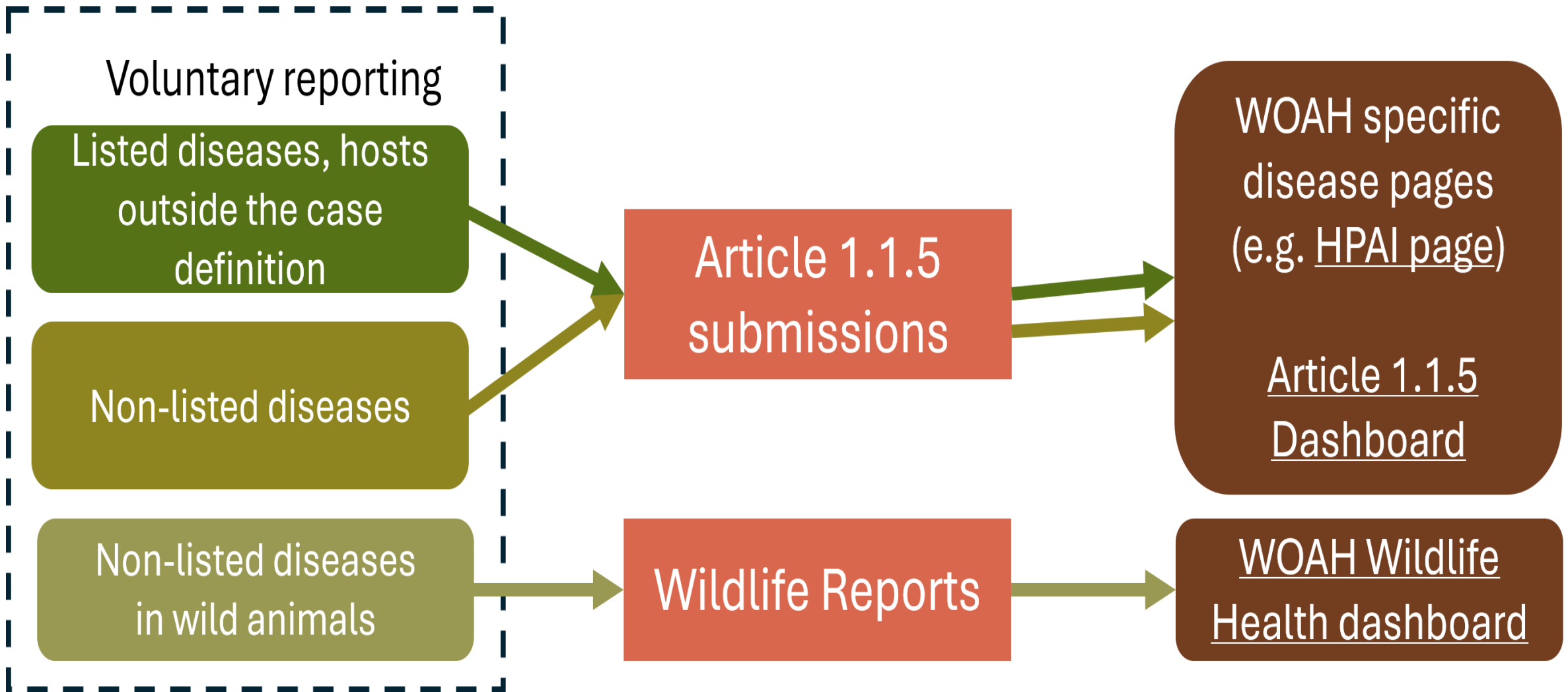


Reporting obligations and support

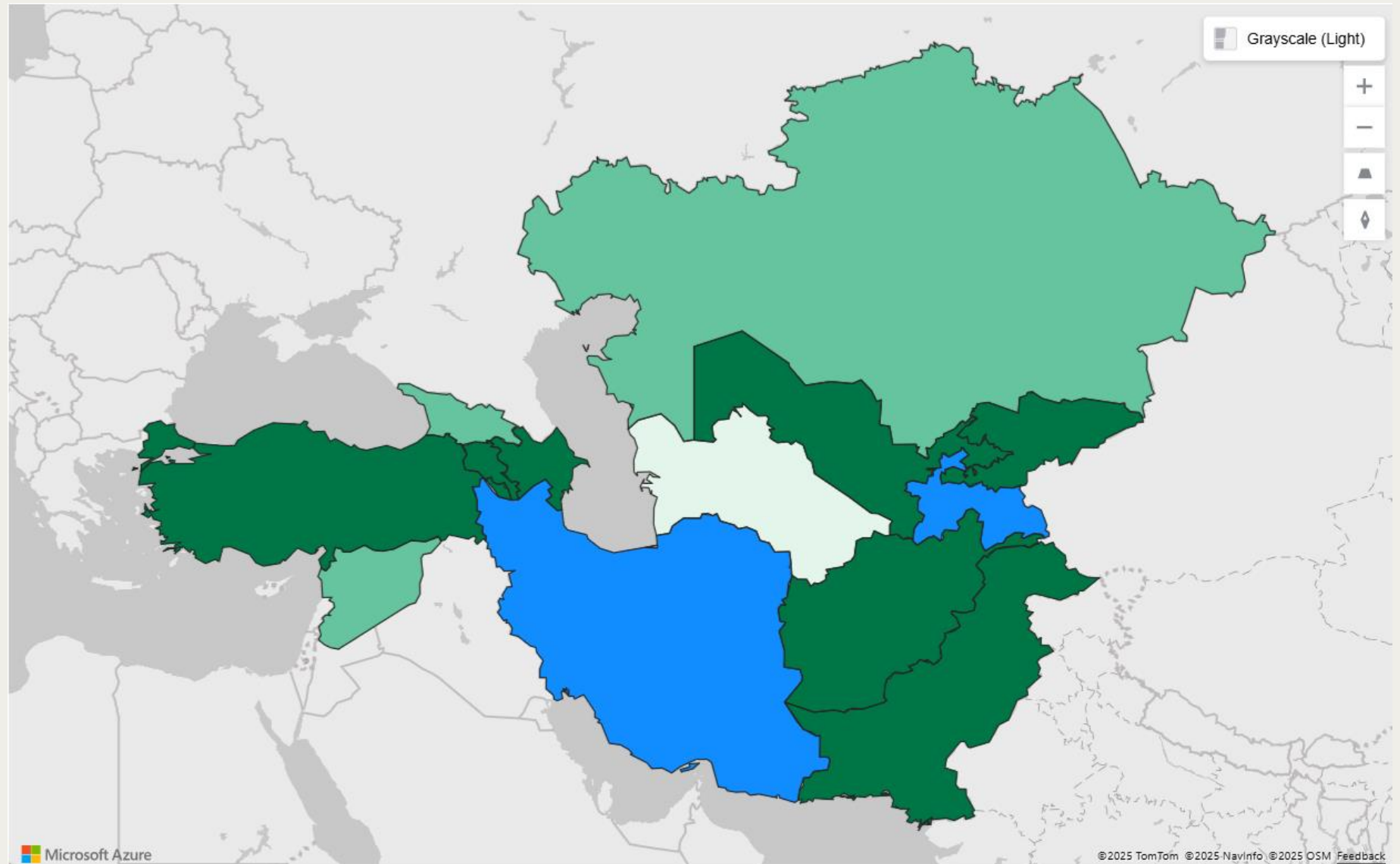

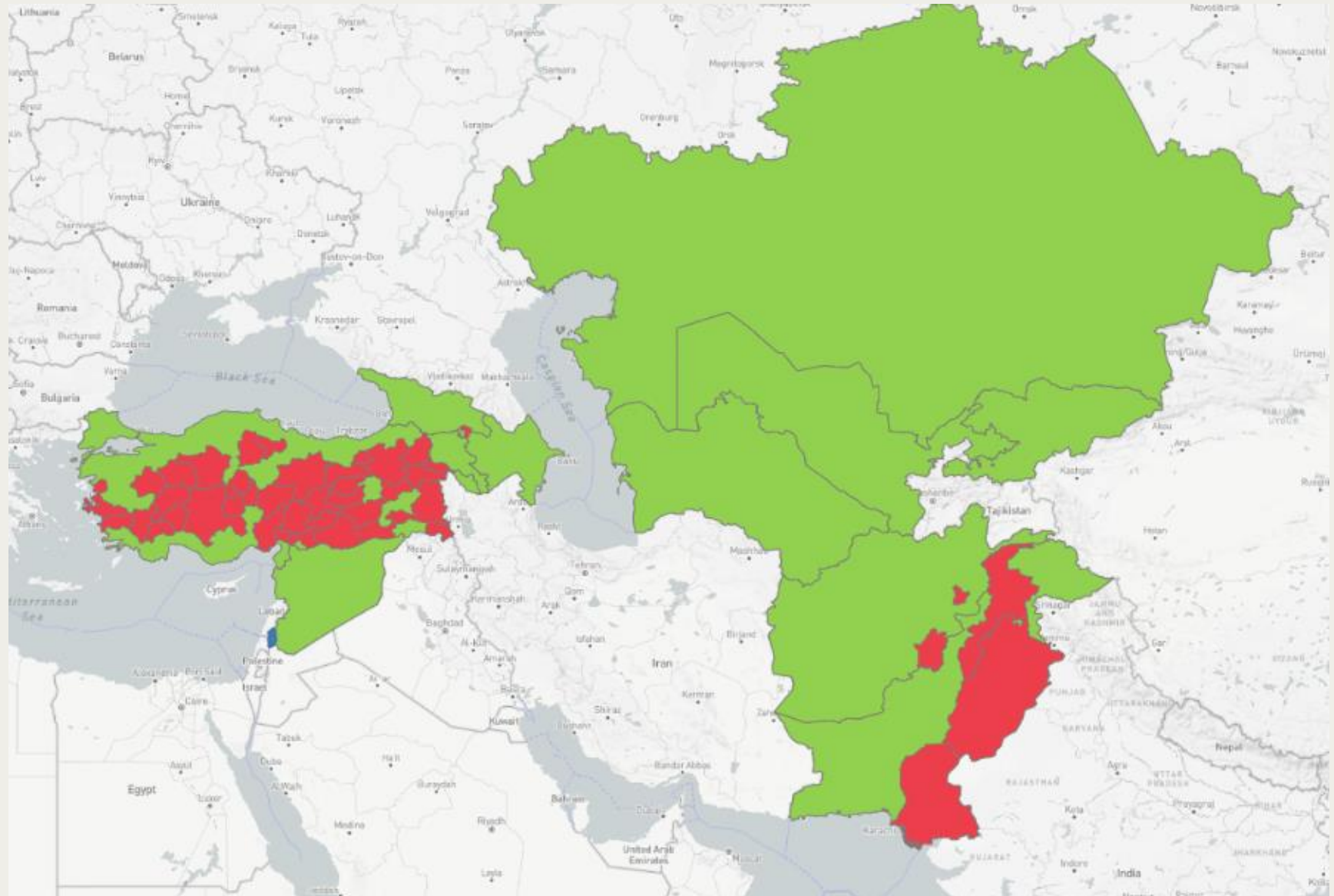

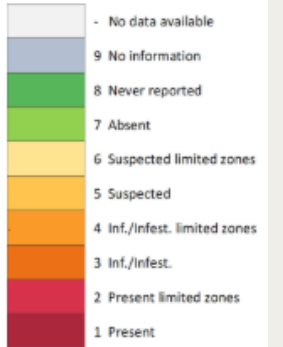

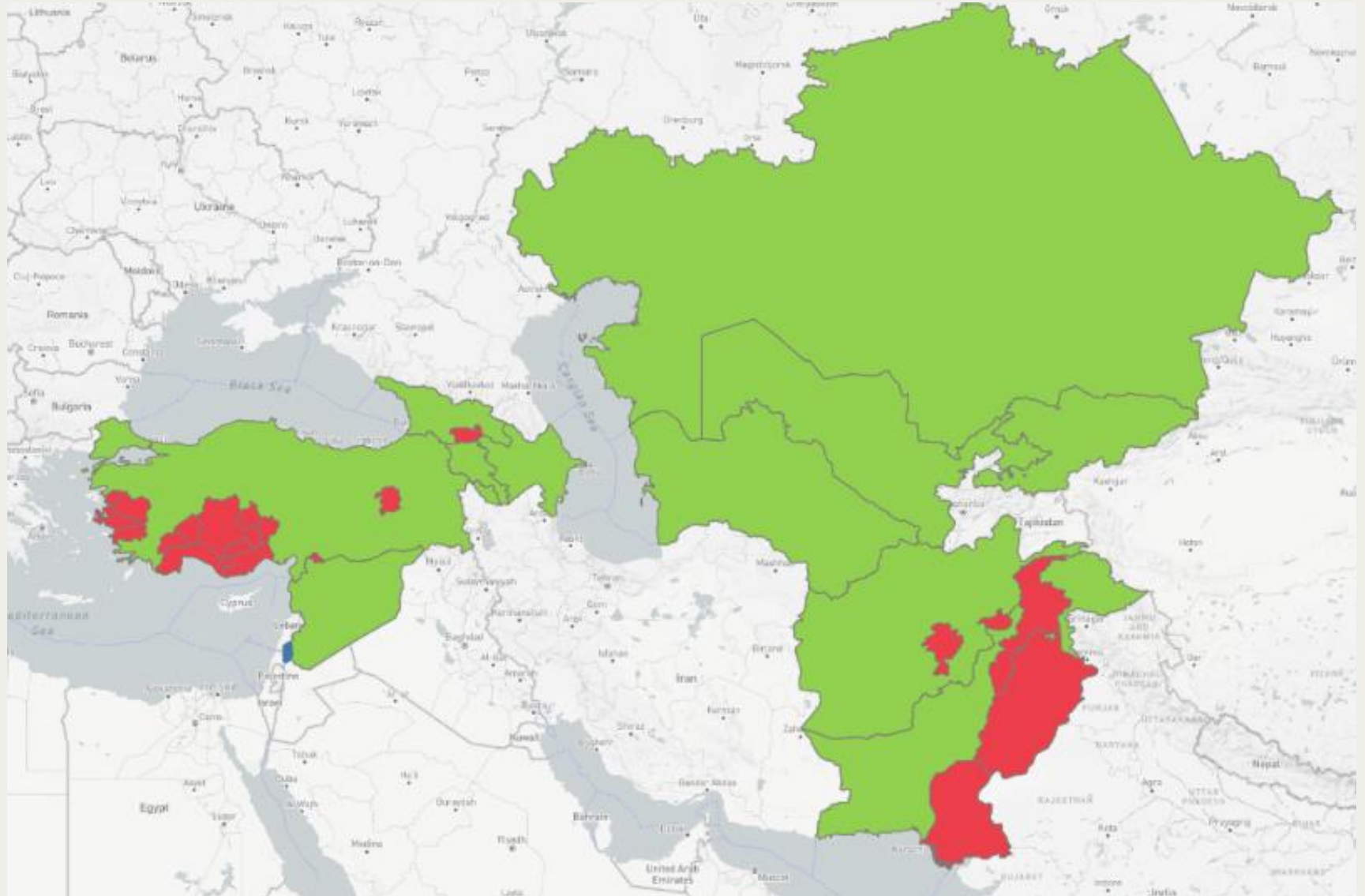

Key messages

➤ To:

- support regional initiatives
- prevent transboundary spread of disease
- meet WOAHP membership obligations and requirements

Reporting must be:

- ✓ complete
- ✓ timely
- ✓ accurate.

- Diseases that are reported only in six-monthly reports should have a corresponding stable event in the events module.
- Diseases that recur after a period of absence must be reported through the events module as an exceptional event.
