Legislation framework in veterinary sector in Bosnia and Herzegovina prescribes control of zoonoses:

- Brucellosis
- Campylobacteriosis
- Listeriosis
- Salmonellosis
- Trichinellosis
- Echinococcosis
- Tuberculosis
- E.coli
- Rabies
- Q fever
- Anthrax
- Other zoonoses in accordance with epidemiological situation

- Cooperation with human sector is mostly incorporated in implementation programmes including mutual reporting of zoonoses
- Programs for control of zoonoses are either annual or multiannual depending on risk assessment

Vaccination strategies:

In Bosnia and Herzegovina vaccination of animals for zoonoses is currently obligatory for rabies (dogs), brucellosis (sheep and goats), anthrax (all susceptible animals in districts) and salmonellosis (laying hens)

Awareness programs and trainings

- Awareness programs and trainings were continuously conducted for different stakeholders (veterinary, human health, hunting, general public...). Several zoonoses during latest years were taken as priority for these activities (rabies, brucellosis, HPAI, salmonellosis) including AMR control.
- Beside competent authorities some activities were supported by EU (Twinning project), WOAH, FAO and other organisations.
