National achievements in implementing One Health

- **National One Health Strategies and coordination mechanisms:**
 - In 2017, a joint One Health Strategy against Antibiotic Resistance was launched.
- **AMR prevention and control:**
 - Since 2018, an independent Advisory Committee on Veterinary Medicines, consisting of experts from veterinarian and human health institutions, has come together regularly to generate recommendations for future AMR policies.
 - In 2024, a One Health AMR group (ICM) was established.

National achievements in implementing One Health

- **Vector-borne and zoonotic diseases:**
 - Since 2022, a coordination group (KOZO), consisting of representatives from human, veterinary and environmental authorities and experts from veterinarian and human health institutions, has met regularly to coordinate handling of suspicions and outbreaks of not foodborne zoonotic diseases.
- **Education, awareness, and workforce development:**
 - The DANMAP report, first published in 1995, presents cross-sector overviews of national data on antimicrobial use and resistance in animals, food and humans on a yearly basis, ensuring transparency and serving public awareness.
