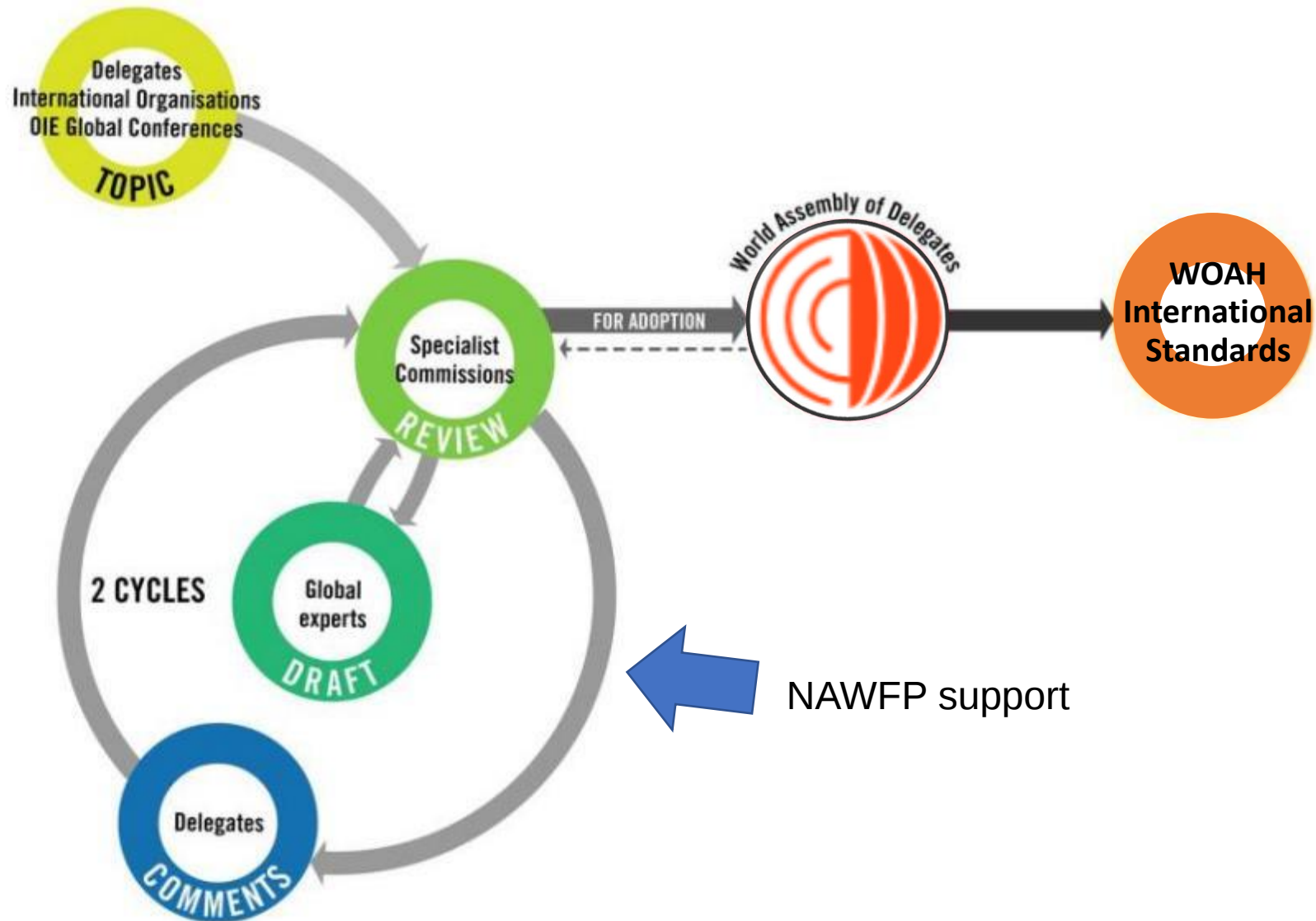


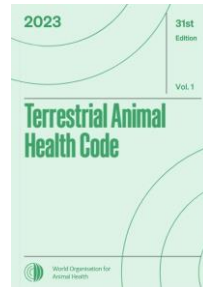
- Establish a network of animal welfare experts within his/her country or communicate with existing network;
- Establish dialogue, cooperation and communication between the Competent Authority for animal welfare and other relevant authorities;
- Receive reports of the Terrestrial Animal Health Standards Commission (Code Commission) and other relevant reports and conduct the in-country consultation process;
- Prepare comments for the Delegate on relevant meeting reports, including comments on the proposals for new or revised WOAHA standards related to animal welfare.
