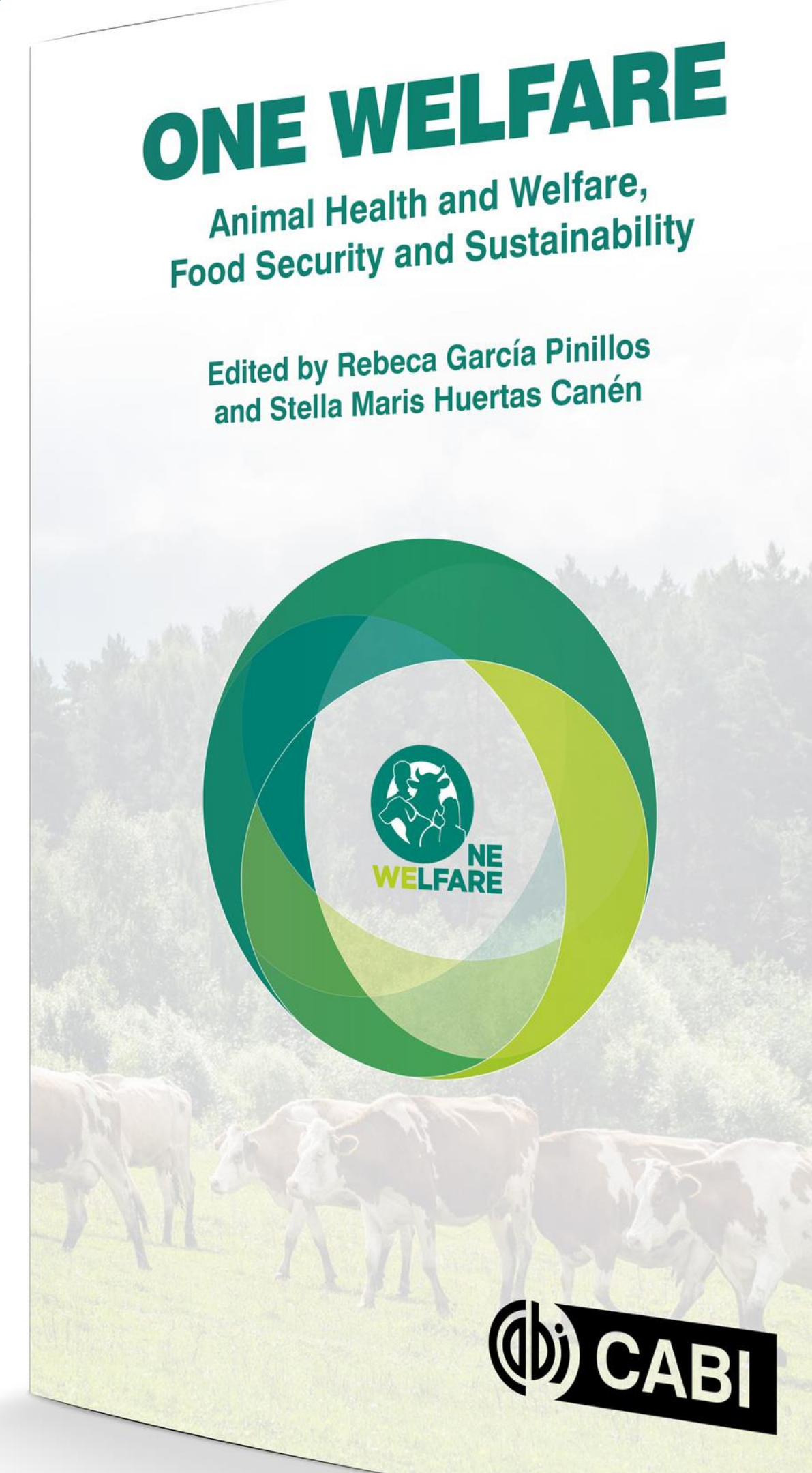

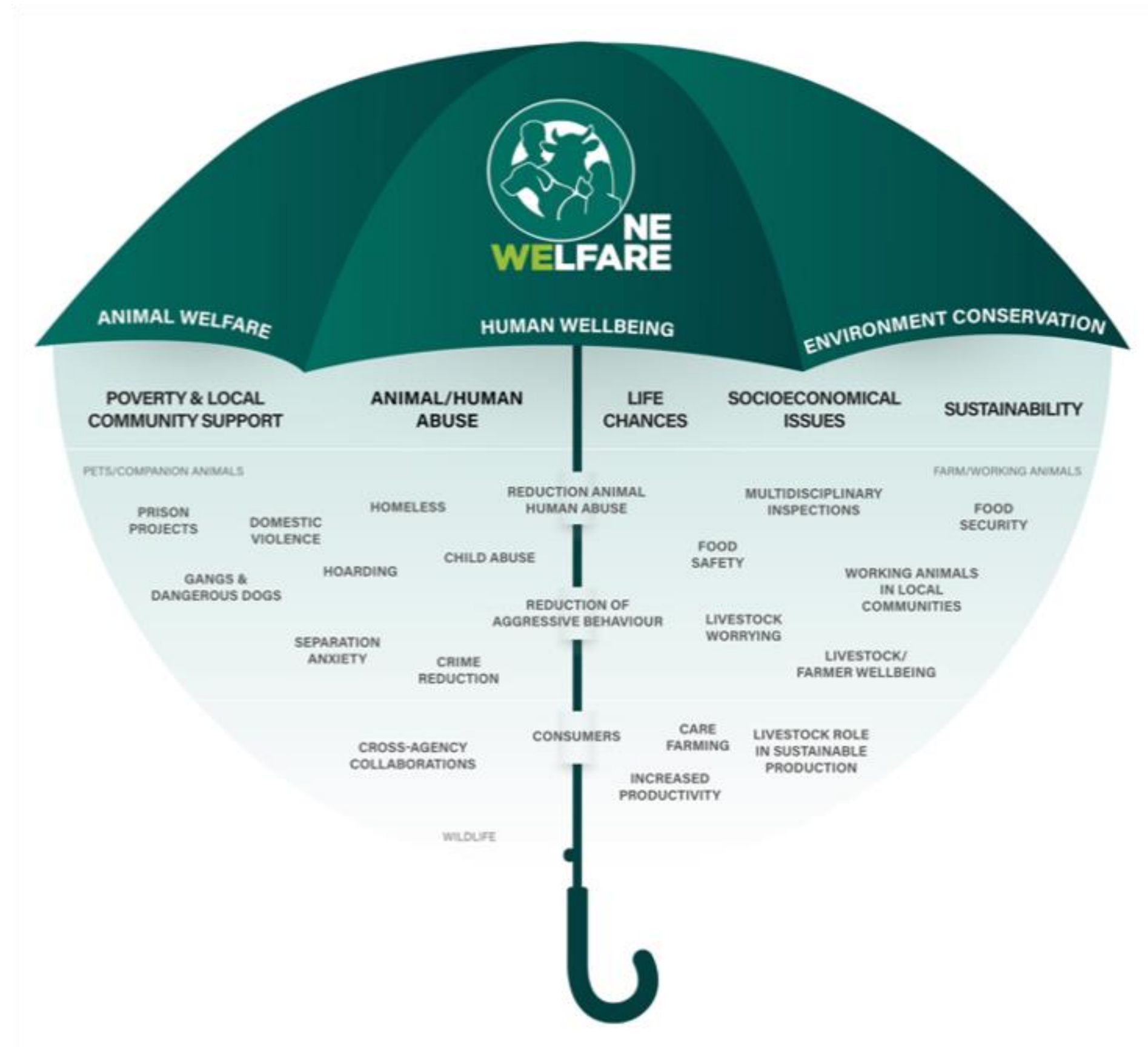

The One Welfare Framework

- Fosters **interdisciplinary collaboration** to improve human and animal welfare internationally.
- Helps **promote key global objectives** (i.e. supporting food security, sustainability, reducing human suffering, improving productivity within the farming sector through better understanding of the value of high welfare standards).
- **Extends the approach of One Health**, used for human and animal health by international organisations.
- Promotes the **direct and indirect links of animal welfare** to human welfare and environmentally friendly animal interactions.
- Establishes **different ways of working** and improved efficiency within local and global networks of those working in animal welfare, human wellbeing and environmental issues.
- Supports the implementation of the **sustainable development agenda and goals**.

Work

Understanding and recognition of the interconnections and impacts of animal welfare work on humans / animals / environment / wider society



Policy

Highlights how animal welfare work/policies impact beyond helping animals, and helps to stop suffering more widely, reaching humans and society.



Research

New discipline including all working on holistic, cross-cutting disciplines focused on animal/human welfare and wellbeing.

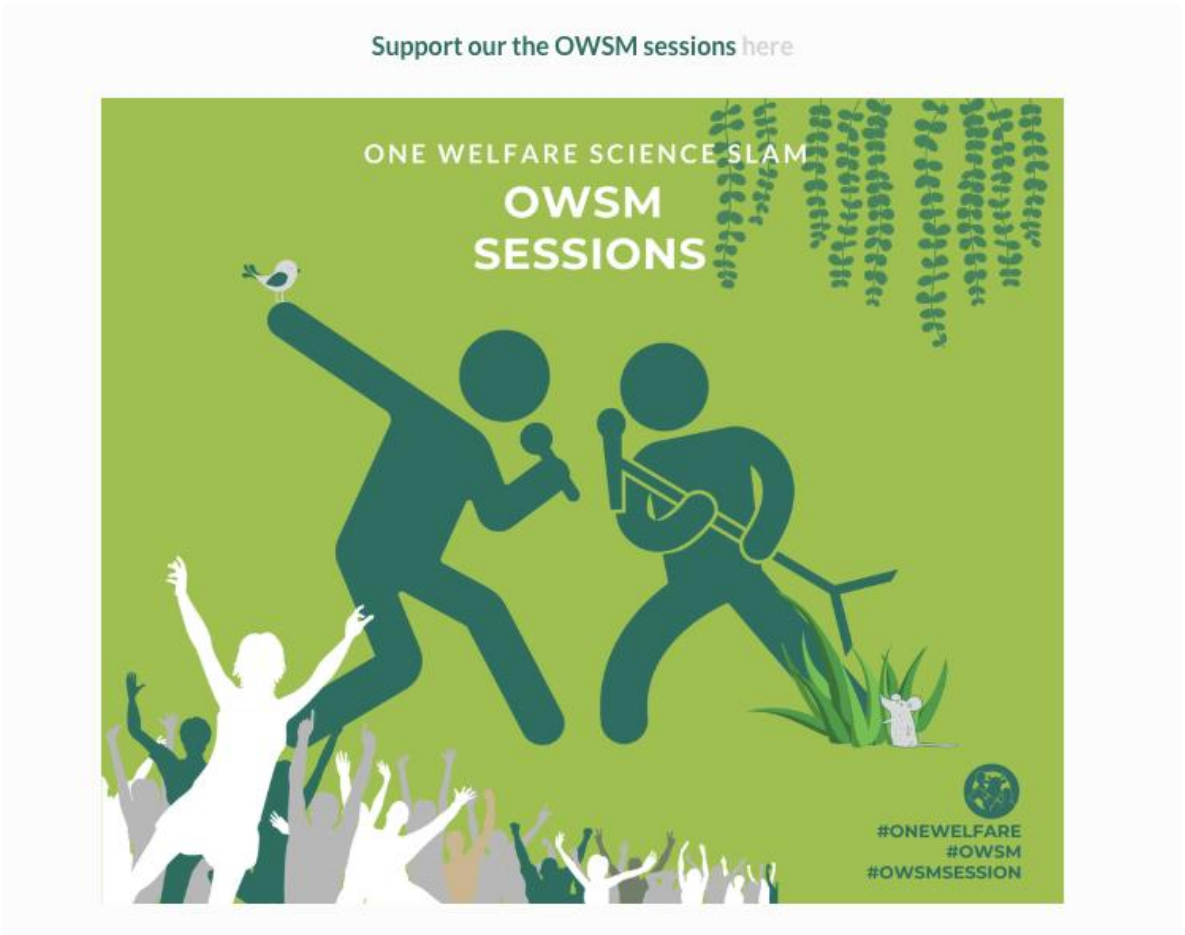

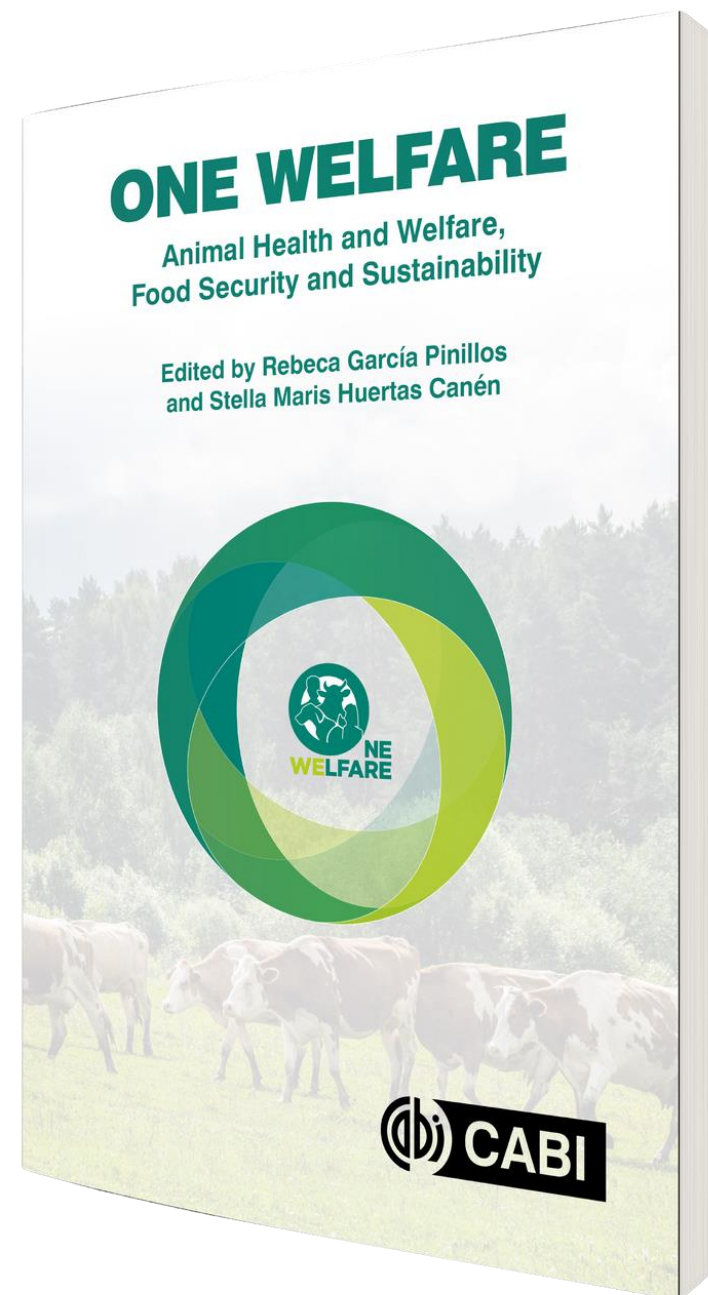

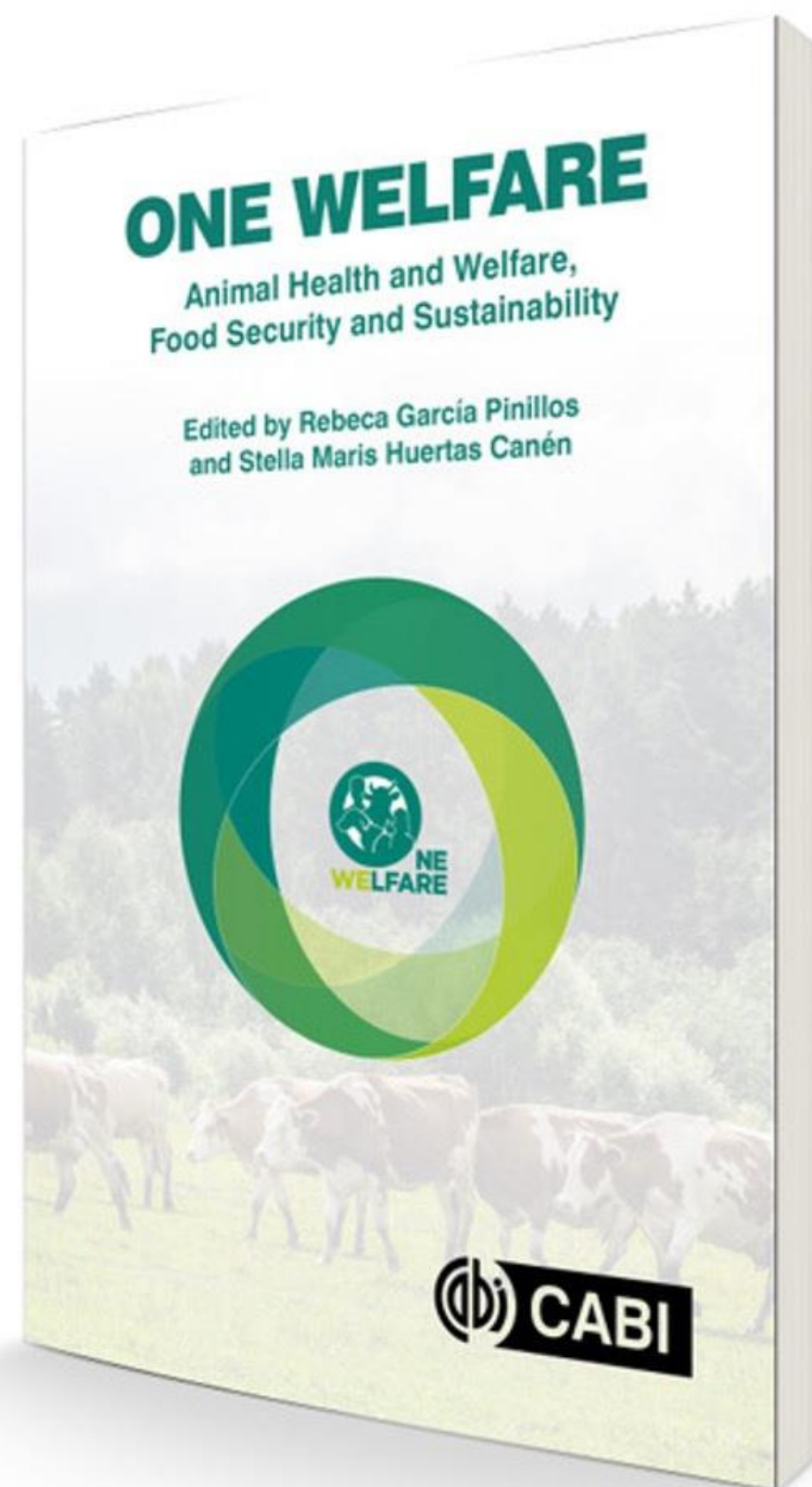
