Objective of the campaign:

Making sure that all actors involved are aware of and take the necessary precautions to prevent the further spread of ASF.



Target audiences

Five stakeholders were included so far:

Regular contact to domestic pigs



Small backyard pig farmers

Commercial pig farms

Contact to wild boar



Hunters

Involved in the transport of pigs and pork products



Travellers

 Transport authorities and check point staff



Objectives for the different target audiences

- Small backyard pig farmers: to respect biosecurity measures on farm and feed pigs responsibly
- Commercial pig farms: to inform all workers and visitors on biosecurity measures
- Hunters: to correctly prevent contact between wild boar and domestic pigs or their products
- Travellers: not to carry illegally pigs or pork products
- Transport authorities and check point staff are informed of ASF infected countries and they control all pork products



ASF Kills Pigs

Key Messages

- ASF is a deadly disease in domestic and wild pigs
- It is not a danger to human health but can cause severe economic losses
- The virus is highly resistant in the environment and in pork products
- There is no vaccine Prevention is crucial

Key Messages


TAKE PRECAUTIONS to prevent the spread of ASF:

- Respect biosecurity measures
- Do not carry pigs or pork products when travelling
- Declare any suspicious case to the veterinary authorities


