Expenses 1279 Keuro instead of budget 527 Keuro:
paid from WF so no impact on the financial year

Findings and practices across standard setting organisations

> Purpose of the project

Observe implementation of standards and challenges for implementation

Not to assess compliance

Collection of information not really clear (PVS, WAHIS...etc)

> Council

Scope of the work needs te be more clearly defined Overlap with PVS should be avoided.



OIE 7th Strategic Plan

> Session with PWC

OIE mission: consensus that mission is clear

Scope of the Mission: need to consider new area's e.g. climate, circular agriculture

> External Forces

Technology, big data, social trends, loss of public trust in governments, decreasing attractiveness of profession, political and economical trends etc

> Consultation will include broad list of stakeholders



Reference Laboratories and collaborating centres

- > Council noted that the applications provide insufficient information to play any other role than endorse.
- Moreover information is provided at the meeting so preparation is not possible
- > OIE responded that a guidance note will be provided in the next meeting
- Discussion on application for CC on traditional medicine: scope, scientific basis.
- > OIE should develop policy note how to traditional and indigenous knowledge should be managed (action Christianne Bruschke)



Application for a sub-regional office Abu Dhabi

- Office for the countries of the GCC (Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf
- > Strong political support from these countries
- Hosted by Abu Dhabi Food Control Authority and government of UAE providing in-kind resources and annual financial contribution, no impact on OIE budget
- Goals: enable livestock sector to be strengthened, synergies with Horn of Africa and provide PVS opportunities
- > Council endorsed opening of this office



OIE partnership management

- > Document "Towards a Strategy on Partnership Management"
- > More focus on institutional partnerships
- > Council expressed concern on some partnerships with individual companies
- > Partnerships will also be part of the next strategic plan.
