- > 2. Financial support for the reimbursement of LSD vaccines purchased and used by Member States and neighbouring third countries through national procedures




1. Direct shipment of LSD vaccines from the EU LSD vaccine bank (1/2)

European Union Lumpy Skin Disease Vaccine Bank

Created on April 2016 to support the <u>initial stages of an LSD vaccination campaign</u>

In 2016, a total of 625.000 doses of live-homologous LSD vaccines have been shipped to the following countries:

Bulgaria, Croatia, Greece, FYROM, Serbia, Kosovo*, Albania, Montenegro






1. Direct shipment of LSD vaccines from the EU LSD vaccine bank (2/2)

In 2017, a total of 325.000 doses of live-homologous LSD vaccines have been shipped to the following countries:

Greece,
Bosnia & Herzegovina, Kosovo*, Albania, Montenegro






1. Direct shipment of LSD vaccines from the EU LSD vaccine bank (2/2)

In 2018, a total of 776.000 doses of live-homologous LSD vaccines have been shipped to the following countries:

Greece,
FYROM, Kosovo*, Albania, Montenegro, Georgia






2. EU financial support for the reimbursement of LSD vaccines purchased and used through national procedures (1/2)

Reimbursement of costs of LSD homologous vaccines purchased and used in 2016

6.307.000 € of EU co-funding for the reimbursement of LSD vaccines used in 2016 in the following countries:

Greece, Bulgaria, Croatia, FYROM, Montenegro, Kosovo*, Serbia, Albania





2. EU financial support for the reimbursement of LSD vaccines purchased and used through national procedures (2/2)

Reimbursement of costs of LSD homologous vaccines purchased and used in 2017 up to 1,1 € per vaccine dose

4.219.699 € of EU co-funding for the reimbursement of LSD vaccines used in 2017 in the following countries:

Greece, Bulgaria, Croatia, FYROM, Montenegro, Serbia, Albania




2. EU financial support for the reimbursement of LSD vaccines purchased and used through national procedures (2/2)
