

Main features of the initial draft of the 3rd Action Plan

Continuity

Same list of priority topics

Inherited from 1st Action Plan:

- > Transport of animals by land, and by sea
- > Slaughter of animals
- Stray dogs population control

Added in the 2nd Action Plan:

- Welfare of animals in disasters
- Welfare of working equids



Evaluation and monitoring

Development of E&M tools wherever it is presently lacking

Within each priority topic:

Transport of animals by land and sea



Slaughter of animals



- Stray dogs population control / SAM Tool already existing
- Welfare of animals in disasters



Welfare of working equids / Evaluation phase already foreseen

At horizontal level, for the Platform as a whole





Transport – MAIN EFFORT

- ❖ 2 Whole Journey Scenario workshops / year, including 1 with Middle-East or North Africa
- Development of the SAM Tool in 2020, 1st self-assessment in 2021

Slaughter

- * 'Refresher' regional seminars 1 in Eastern Europe (2020), 1 in the Balkans (2021)
- Development of the SAM Tool in 2022



Stray dog population control

- Follow up of the 2 existing roadmaps:
 - Balkan Roadmap objective 2025
 - West Eurasia roadmap, objective 2030

```
For each roadmap: → 1 workshop every 2 years
→ 1 self-assessment exercise each second year
```

Disaster management

- Last workshop of the 3-years pilot project for the Balkans in 2020
- Regional needs' assessment in 2021
- Possibly a new project starting in 2022



Working equids

Provided that the baseline survey 2019 shows it is relevant:

- Development of the awareness campaign material in 2020, + launch of the campaign with a physical workshop
- Deployment of the campaign in 2021
- Evaluation phase in 2022



Governance of the Platform

- 2 meetings of the Steering Group per year
- * (and regular communication at the RCG and Regional Commission level)

Stakeholder coordination

1 meeting per year

Communication

- Website update
- * Annual newsletters
- Russian translations

Monitoring and evaluation

- Identification of horizontal indicators
- Second external evaluation in 2022?
