1. Chronology

- √ 09/09/2018: first case of ASF in wild board in the south of Belgium.
- √ 26/09 03/10/18: preventive culling of pigs in the infected zone
- ✓ 12/10/18: delineation by the Walloon Region of 3 "operational" zones within the infected zone, with a view to the management of wild boars
 - kernel zone
 - buffer zone
 - reinforced observation zone
- √ 23/11/18: Adaptation European zoning
 - Delineation of zone I (buffer) and zone II (infected)
 - Region: delineation of a vigilance zone














2. Current situation

As at 01/03/2019

- > 1,851 wild boars found dead or shot were tested and analysed
 - 1,754 in the "infected zone"
 - 640 positive ASF
- No outbreak in domestic pigs








2. Current situation

Strategic objectives for eradicating the disease

- Knowledge of the situation & its evolution
- Limiting & preventing spread among wild boars
- Eliminating contaminated carcasses (= removing the source of infection)
- Progressive and adapted elimination of all wild boar



Basis for the definition of zones


- 1. Presence of the ASF virus
- Habitat of wild boar & forested areas
- 3. Existing natural or artificial barriers







Wild Boar: Measures in zones I and II




Destruction objective: 0 boars = "depopulation zone"







Traps


