LSD epidemiology – evolution since the SG4

This year in Kosovo there was no outbrakes of LSD Disease

 There was no animals with clinical characteristic signs of LSD Disease

There was no dead animals from LSD Disease



Control measures applied

- The Kosovo Food and Veterinary Agency (FVA) has held meetings with private veterinarians through Veterinary Chamber of Kosovo:
- To raise their awareness of their surveillance and reporting responsibilities;
- To plan their involvement in a cattle mass vaccination campaign, including payment for their service.
- FVA inspectors are prepared to follow up reports of infected animals and are equipped to sample them.
- Vaccination campaign has started on 06.07.2017 and completed 20.08.2017.
- There are distributed 55,000 doses of vaccines as the donation of EU
- Kosovo Government has distributed 310,000 doses of vaccines
- Cattles are vaccinated in 37 Municipalities,
- 215,502 heads of cattle are vaccinated.



Vaccination plan for 2018

- Government of Kosovo has allocated funding for purchase of 300,000 doses of LSD vaccine;
- Vaccination will start from 25.05.2018 and shall be finished on 30.06.2018.
- We will require donation from EU for extra 60,000 doses of LSD Vaccines.



Specific challenges met since the LSD 4?

- FVA officials are monitoring vaccination in the field
- Final report is done for LSD Vaccination
- Best results are achieved this year comparing with the previous year.
 Vaccination is done on time.
