#### CONSIDERIN

- That animal welfare, including the key component animal health, is the subject of OIE standards and guidelines,
- That the Technical item of the 25th Regional Conference of the Regional Commission for Europe held in Germany on 17-21 September 2012 was: «Regional steps towards common Animal Welfare approach in Europe»,
- The <u>Concept Note</u> "Proposed action to support OIE Member Countries in Eastern Europe in the implementation of the DIE standards on animal health and welfare", which was drafted and eventually officially endorsed in May 2013,
- The subsequent launch of the "DIE Platform on Animal Welfare for Europe" (further referred to as "the Platform"), the full implementation of its action plan 2014-2016 and the ongoing implementation of the second action plan 2017-2019,
- The continuous need to improve the efficiency of veterinary services in the countries of Eastern Europe particularly with respect to the effective implementation of the OIE standards and guidelines on animal welfare, including the key component arimal health,
- The opinion expressed by the Regional Core Group during the seventh meeting in Bern, 17-18 December 2018 and the conclusions of the external availuation of the Platform conducted in January-April 2019.

- (iii) Offering a platform for dialogue and exchange on best practices in animal welfare and, as appropriate, animal health and veterinary public health; for information and knowledge; and to enhance scientific cooperation.



## **Governance of the Platform**

The Platform is governed by the **Steering Group**, under the supervision of the OIE Regional Commission for Europe.

The **Secretariat** of the Steering Group (further referred to as "the Secretariat") is ensured by the OIE sub-Regional Representation in Brussels.



## Responsibilities of the Steering Group

- (i) Providing guidance to the Secretariat for the drafting of the Action Plan, assessing and approving the draft Action Plan before it is submitted to the OIE Regional Commission for Europe for endorsement;
- (ii) Monitoring the implementation of the action plan, providing guidance and recommendations on the activities and, where necessary, approving adjustments to the initial plans;
- (iii) Providing support in terms of methodology, data, resources or any other need expressed by the Secretariat;
- (iv) Liaising with the other members of the OIE Regional Commission for Europe to explain and promote the activities of the Platform and collect their comments and suggestions.



# Responsibilities of the Secretariat

- (i) Proposing dates and venues for the Steering Group meetings, ensuring the logistical organisation in coordination with the hosting parties, drafting the agendas and preparing the reports;
- (ii) Drafting the Action Plan of the Platform;
- (iii) Implementing the approved Action Plan of the Platform, including the organisation of workshops and the drafting of various documents;
- (iv) Monitoring the financial resources and expenses incurred in the implementation of activities;
- (v) Maintaining and updating the website of the Platform;
- (vi) Reporting to the Steering Group.



## Composition of the Steering Group

- Chairperson: a member of the Bureau of the OIE Regional Commission for Europe,
- 3 Member Countries (non EU or EFTA)
- 2 Member Countries (EU or EFTA)
- OIE HQ
- European Commission / DG SANTE,
- OIE AW Collaborating Centre
- representative of donor Member Countries
- representative of donor organizations\*
- representatives of the OIE RR in Moscow and the SRR for Central Asia and SRR in Brussels.



# Appointment and renewal of the Steering Group members

The Chairperson and the Members are selected during the meetings of the Regional Commission for Europe, taking into account the sub-regional balance and current priority topics addressed by the Platform, for a three-year mandate (renewable). A progressive rotation of the Members is advisable.

The representative of donor Member Countries and the representative of donor organisations are selected by the Regional Core Group for a three-year mandate (renewable) or for as long as they are a donor to the Platform.



# **Functioning of the Steering Group**

- Meetings every six months with a location on a rotational basis.
- Chaired by a member of the Bureau of the OIE Regional Commission for Europe (or OIE Delegate of MC).
- Members generally are represented by the OIE Delegates (exceptionally represented by their national focal point on animal welfare or another empowered representative).
- The decisions based on consensus. If vote would be necessary, only the chairperson and the Members have the right to vote (one member = one vote).
