



Outbreaks in domestic pigs – country map

Period considered - 1.9.-20.4.2020 – <u>NO OUTBREAKS IN DOMESTIC PIGS</u> - the outbreaks in domestic pigs only in period July- August 2019 - from 25.7.2019 – till 5.9.2019 – <u>11 outbreaks in domestic pigs and 12 positive WB</u>



COVID 19 and Slovak Republic

Situation: 28.4.2020- 1 384 infected, 20 dead, 423 people recovered (75 866 tests)

The role of SVFA- CVO is an active member of departmental crisis stuff. SVFA issued a special guidelines how to prevent the introduction and spread of COVID-19 into the farms as well as into food production establishments. Guidelines issued

- a) for farmers
- b) for FBOs

Animal health, animal welfare, food safety and animal movement (certification) must be guaranteed during this difficult period without stopping and negative impact to animals and availability of food for Slovak citizens

Slovak veterinary service (State veterinary nstititute) is involved in the system of laboratory diagnostics of corona virus in humans

In Slovakia, we have mastered the dignostic of coronavirus in animals and food

ASF- surveillance activities- have not been stopped, performed in a "normal" modus as described in eradication plan of ASF for Slovakia taking into account different sampling schema for different parts of Slovakia (free zone, buffer zones, part I, part II- as described in CID 2014/709/EC)
