
# Cases in wild boar – country map




### Outbreaks in domestic pigs

During the period 01.09.2019 – 30.04.2020 we have tested totally 3902 domestic pigs, including 1569 dead domestic pigs. All results have been ASF negative.

The last domestic pig outbreak was in September 2017.

Estonia declared to the OIE freedom from ASF in domestic pigs and captive feral pigs from September 2017.
