Main outcomes

- 1. the commitment of regional cooperation in control of FMD and PPR is confirmed
- 2. the timetable for the regional vision is updated;
- 3. the international organizations confirm their assistance to countries to progress along the regional Roadmaps;
- 4. for FMD Roadmap the global strategy thus far has been successfully implemented in the 14 countries of the West Eurasia roadmap, where 2 countries are free with/without vaccination and 1 with endorsed NAP

Main challenges

(taken from 8th West Eurasia FMD Roadmap Meeting)

- 1. political commitment and financial support for the control programme;
- 2. geopolitical differences that affect regional ownership;
- 3. the appropriate legislation;
