

How COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

Period considered (From March 2020 to November 2020)

- 1) Restrictions due to the covid-19 pandemic and the control measures applied in central and local Veterinary Authorities:
 - Compulsory teleworking in at least 50% of the staff.
 - Compulsory absence of veterinarians in certain local services due to confirmed covid 19 infection (e.g. Komotini and Serres RUs).
 Reduced field work by official veterinarians.
- 2) Prohibition of hunting activities. Inability for passive and active surveillance in wild boars



Outbreaks in domestic pigs

Period considered (ideally 05 May 2020 to 23 November 2020):
