Cases in wild boar – Germany



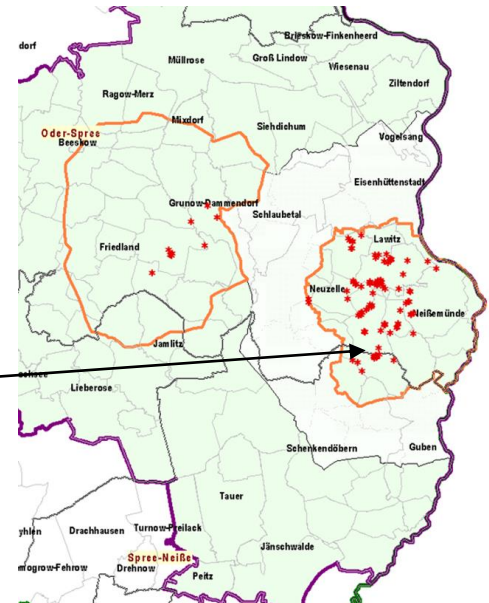
Since 10th September 2020

Buffer zone - infected area - core area



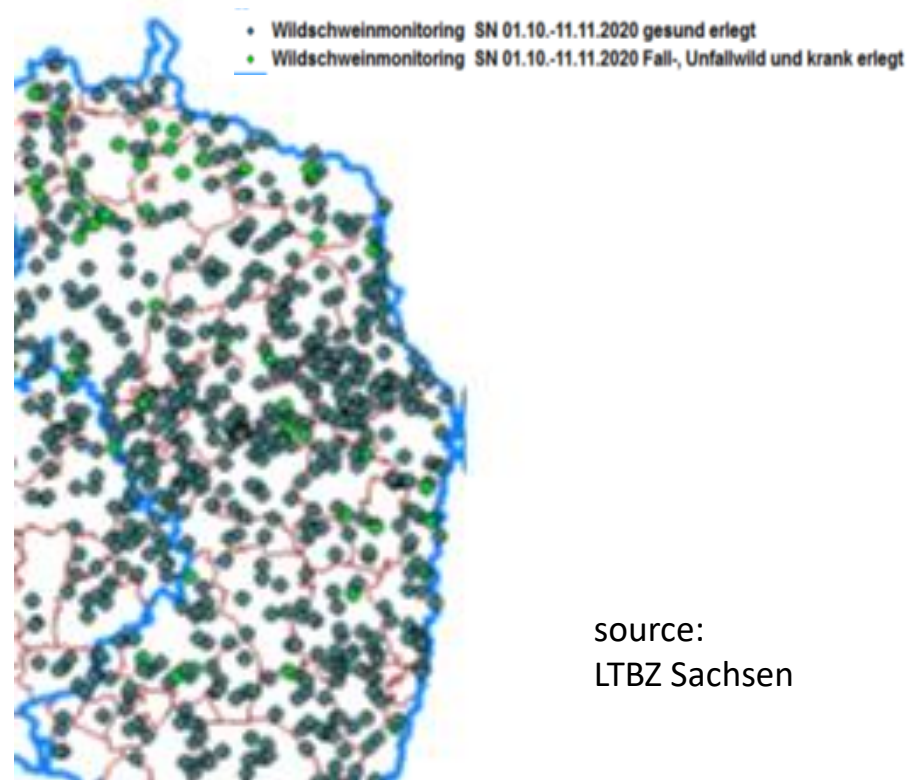
first found wild boar

Wild boar surveillance

In the districts of the country considered free

Wild boar - found dead

Period considered	N° wild boar found dead	% PCR positive	% seropositive
May 2020 to November 2020	732	0	0

Wild boar - hunted

Period considered	N° wild boar hunted	% PCR positive	% seropositive
May 2020 to November 2020	20.961	0	0

In the 4 districts of the country with parts being affected since September 10th 2020

Wild boar - found dead

Period considered	N° wild boar found dead	% PCR positive	% seropositive
May 2020 to November 2020	304	43.75	0

Wild boar - hunted

Period considered	N° wild boar hunted	% PCR positive	% seropositive
May 2020 to November 2020	4.357	0.12	0

Domestic pigs surveillance in 2020

Germany considered free of ASF in domestic pigs - preliminary data

Bundesland	N° of pigs tested with negative results
Baden-Württemberg	6.010
Hesse	1.463
Mecklenburg-West Pomerania	2.858
Rhineland-Palatinate	23
Saxony	4209
Saxony - Anhalt	754
Thuringia	2.959
